AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; CLARIFYING ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AT PUBLIC POST-SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS FOR CERTAIN STUDENTS.

Section 1. HOME SCHOOL STUDENTS—ADMISSION

REQUIREMENTS—PUBLIC POST—SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL

INSTITUTIONS.—In determining the standard of requirements for admission to any public post—secondary educational institution, the board of regents, governing board or community college board shall not require a student who has completed the requirements of a home—based or non—public school educational program and who has submitted test scores that otherwise qualify him for admission to that institution, to obtain or submit proof of having obtained a general equivalency diploma certificate. In determining requirements for admission, the board of regents, governing board or community college board shall evaluate and treat applicants from home—based or non—public educational

programs fairly and in a nondiscriminatory manner.
