11	RELATING TO COURTS; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
13	Section 1. SHORT TITLEThis act may be cited as the "Court Appropriation Act of 1999".
14	Section 2. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999:
15	A. "agency" means an office, department, agency, institution, board, bureau, commission, court
16	district attorney, council or committee of state government;
<b>17</b>	B. "expenditures" means costs, expenses, encumbrances and other financing uses, other than
18	refunds authorized by law, recognized in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles for the
19	legally authorized budget amounts and budget period;
20	C. "federal funds" means any payments by the United States government to state government or
21	agencies except those payments made in accordance with the federal Mineral Lands Leasing Act;
22	D. "full-time employee" or "FTE" means one or more authorized positions that together receive
23	compensation for not more than two thousand ninety-six hours worked in fiscal year 2000. The calculation
24	of hours worked includes compensated absences but does not include overtime, compensatory time or sick
25	leave paid pursuant to Section 10-7-10 NMSA 1978;

- 1 E. "general fund" means that fund created by Section 6-4-2 NMSA 1978 and includes federal
  2 Mineral Lands Leasing Act receipts, but excludes the general fund operating reserve, the appropriation
  3 contingency fund and the risk reserve;
- F. "interagency transfers" means revenue, other than internal service funds, legally transferred from one agency to another;
- **6** G. "internal service funds" means:
- 7 (1) revenue transferred to an agency for the financing of goods or services to another 8 agency on a cost-reimbursement basis; and
- 9 (2) unencumbered balances in agency internal service fund accounts appropriated by the 10 Court Appropriation Act of 1999;
- 11 H. "other state funds" means:
- 12 (1) unencumbered, nonreverting balances in state agency accounts, other than in internal 13 service funds accounts, appropriated by the Court Appropriation Act of 1999;
- (2) all revenue available to state agencies from sources other than the general fund, internal service funds, interagency transfers and federal funds; and
- (3) all revenue, the use of which is restricted by statute or agreement;
- 17 I. "revenue" means all money received by an agency from sources external to that agency, net of
  18 refunds and other correcting transactions, other than from issue of debt, liquidation of investments or as
  19 agent or trustee for other governmental entities or private persons; and
- J. "unforseen federal funds" means a source of federal funds or an increased amount of federal funds that could not have been reasonably anticipated or known during the first session of the fortyfourth legislature and, therefore, could not have been requested by an agency or appropriated by the
  legislature.
- 24 Section 3. FORMAT.--The general format of the appropriations set forth in the Court Appropriation 25 Act of 1999 with respect to symbols used, column headings and amounts stated are those used in the General

1 Appropriation Act of 1999.

Section 4. GENERAL PROVISIONS. --

- A. Amounts set out under column headings are expressed in thousands of dollars.
- B. Amounts set out under column headings are appropriated from the source indicated by the column heading. All amounts set out under the column heading "Internal Service Funds/Interagency Transfers" indicate an intergovernmental transfer and do not represent a portion of total state government appropriations. All information designated as "Totals" or "Subtotals" are provided for information and are not appropriations.
- C. Amounts set out in Section 5 of the Court Appropriation Act of 1999, or so much as may be necessary, are appropriated from the indicated source for expenditure in fiscal year 2000 for the objects expressed.
- D. Unencumbered balances in agency accounts remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund by October 1, 1999, unless otherwise indicated in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999 or otherwise provided by law.
- E. Unencumbered balances in agency accounts remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the general fund by October 1, 2000, unless otherwise indicated in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999 or otherwise provided by law.
- F. The state budget division shall monitor revenue received by agencies from sources other than the general fund and shall reduce the operating budget of any agency whose revenue from such sources is not meeting projections. The state budget division shall notify the legislative finance committee of any operating budget reduced pursuant to this subsection.
- G. Except as otherwise specifically stated in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999, appropriations are made in that act for the expenditures of agencies and for other purposes as required by existing law for fiscal year 2000. If any other act of the first session of the forty-fourth legislature, changes existing law with regard to the name or responsibilities of an agency or the name or purpose of a

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fund or distribution, the appropriation made in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999 shall be transferred from the agency, fund or distribution to which an appropriation has been made as required by existing law to the appropriate agency, fund or distribution provided by the new law.

- H. Pursuant to Sections 6-3-23 through 6-3-25 NMSA 1978, agencies whose revenue from unforseen federal funds, from state board of finance loans, from revenue appropriated by other acts of the legislature, or from gifts, donations, bequests, insurance settlements, refunds or payments into revolving funds exceed specifically appropriated amounts may request budget increases from the state budget division. If approved by the state budget division such money is appropriated. In approving a budget increase from unforseen federal funds, the director of the state budget division shall advise the legislative finance committee as to the source of the federal funds and the source and amount of any matching funds required.
- I. For fiscal year 2000, the number of permanent and term full-time equivalent positions specified for each agency shows the maximum number of employees intended by the legislature for that agency, unless another provision of the Court Appropriation Act of 1999 or another act of the first session of the forty-fourth legislature provides for additional employees.
- J. Except for gasoline credit cards used solely for the operation of official vehicles and telephone credit cards used solely for official business, none of the appropriations contained in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999 may be expended for payment of credit card invoices.
- K. To prevent unnecessary spending, expenditures from the Court Appropriation Act of 1999 for gasoline for state-owned vehicles at public gasoline service stations shall be made only for self-service gasoline; provided that a state agency head may provide exceptions from the requirement to accommodate disabled persons or for other reasons the public interest may require.
- L. When approving operating budgets based on appropriations in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999, the state budget division is specifically authorized to approve only those budgets that are in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles for the purpose of properly classifying other

13	Section 1. SHORT TITLEThis act may be cited as the "Court Appropriation Act of 1999".
14	Section 2. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999:
15	A. "agency" means an office, department, agency, institution, board, bureau, commission, court
16	district attorney, council or committee of state government;
17	B. "expenditures" means costs, expenses, encumbrances and other financing uses, other than
18	refunds authorized by law, recognized in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles for the
19	legally authorized budget amounts and budget period;
20	C. "federal funds" means any payments by the United States government to state government or
21	agencies except those payments made in accordance with the federal Mineral Lands Leasing Act;

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1 D. "full-time employee" or "FTE" means one or more authorized positions that together receive 2 compensation for not more than two thousand ninety-six hours worked in fiscal year 2000. The calculation 3 of hours worked includes compensated absences but does not include overtime, compensatory time or sick 4 leave paid pursuant to Section 10-7-10 NMSA 1978; 5 E. "general fund" means that fund created by Section 6-4-2 NMSA 1978 and includes federal 6 Mineral Lands Leasing Act receipts, but excludes the general fund operating reserve, the appropriation 7 contingency fund and the risk reserve; 8 F. "interagency transfers" means revenue, other than internal service funds, legally 9 transferred from one agency to another; 10 G. "internal service funds" means: 11 (1) revenue transferred to an agency for the financing of goods or services to another 12 agency on a cost-reimbursement basis; and 13 (2) unencumbered balances in agency internal service fund accounts appropriated by the 14 Court Appropriation Act of 1999; 15 H. "other state funds" means: 16 (1) unencumbered, nonreverting balances in state agency accounts, other than in internal 17 service funds accounts, appropriated by the Court Appropriation Act of 1999; 18 (2) all revenue available to state agencies from sources other than the general fund,

(3) all revenue, the use of which is restricted by statute or agreement;

internal service funds, interagency transfers and federal funds; and

- I. "revenue" means all money received by an agency from sources external to that agency, net of refunds and other correcting transactions, other than from issue of debt, liquidation of investments or as agent or trustee for other governmental entities or private persons; and
- J. "unforseen federal funds" means a source of federal funds or an increased amount of federal funds that could not have been reasonably anticipated or known during the first session of the forty-fourth legislature and, therefore, could not have been requested by an agency or appropriated by the legislature.
- 8 Section 3. FORMAT.--The general format of the appropriations set forth in the Court Appropriation
  9 Act of 1999 with respect to symbols used, column headings and amounts stated are those used in the General
  10 Appropriation Act of 1999.
- 11 Section 4. GENERAL PROVISIONS.--

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- 12 A. Amounts set out under column headings are expressed in thousands of dollars.
- B. Amounts set out under column headings are appropriated from the source indicated by the column heading. All amounts set out under the column heading "Internal Service Funds/Interagency

  Transfers" indicate an intergovernmental transfer and do not represent a portion of total state government appropriations. All information designated as "Totals" or "Subtotals" are provided for information and are not appropriations.
- 18 C. Amounts set out in Section 5 of the Court Appropriation Act of 1999, or so much as may be
  19 necessary, are appropriated from the indicated source for expenditure in fiscal year 2000 for the objects
  20 expressed.

D. Unencumbered balances in agency accounts remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund by October 1, 1999, unless otherwise indicated in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999 or otherwise provided by law.

- E. Unencumbered balances in agency accounts remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the general fund by October 1, 2000, unless otherwise indicated in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999 or otherwise provided by law.
- F. The state budget division shall monitor revenue received by agencies from sources other than the general fund and shall reduce the operating budget of any agency whose revenue from such sources is not meeting projections. The state budget division shall notify the legislative finance committee of any operating budget reduced pursuant to this subsection.
- G. Except as otherwise specifically stated in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999, appropriations are made in that act for the expenditures of agencies and for other purposes as required by existing law for fiscal year 2000. If any other act of the first session of the forty-fourth legislature, changes existing law with regard to the name or responsibilities of an agency or the name or purpose of a fund or distribution, the appropriation made in the Court Appropriation Act of 1999 shall be transferred from the agency, fund or distribution to which an appropriation has been made as required by existing law to the appropriate agency, fund or distribution provided by the new law.
- H. Pursuant to Sections 6-3-23 through 6-3-25 NMSA 1978, agencies whose revenue from unforseen federal funds, from state board of finance loans, from revenue appropriated by other acts of the legislature, or from gifts, donations, bequests, insurance settlements, refunds or payments into revolving funds exceed specifically appropriated amounts may request budget increases from the state budget division. If approved by the state budget division such money is appropriated. In approving a budget increase from unforseen federal funds, the director of the state budget division shall advise the legislative finance committee as to the source of the federal funds and the source and amount of any
