AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL LAW; CHANGING THE ELEMENTS OF THE CRIME OF ROBBERY; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE CRIMINAL CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 30-16-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1963, Chapter 303, Section 16-2, as amended) is amended to read:

"30-16-2. ROBBERY. - -

A. Robbery consists of the theft or retention immediately after a theft of anything of value from the person of another or from the immediate control of another by use or threatened use of force or violence.

- $\underline{\textbf{B.}}$ Whoever commits robbery is guilty of a third degree felony.
- C. Whoever commits robbery while armed with a deadly weapon is, for the first offense, guilty of a second . 124813.1
