be it enacted by the legl slature of the state of new mexi co:
Section 1. Section 66-3-409 NNSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1978, Chapter 199, Section 1 , as amended) is amended to read:
" 66-3-409. SPECI AL REGI STRATI ON PLATES- - MEDAL OF HONOR RECI PI ENTS. --
A. The [division] department shall issue di stinctive pale bl ue, white and gold registration plates for up to two vehicles to [any] a person who has been awarded the medal of honor and who so requests and submits proof satisfactory to the [ division] department that he has been . 125196. 1
awar ded that medal. The pl ates shall each bear the inscription "Medal of Honor Reci pi ent". No fee, including the regul ar registration fee applicable to the passenger motor vehi cle, if any, shall be collected for the issuance of a special regi stration pl ate pursuant to this section.
B. No person shall fal sel y represent himself to be a medal of honor recipient in order to be eligible to be issued special registration pl ates pursuant to this section when he is in fact not such a reci pient. [ Any] A person who vi ol ates the provisions of this subsection is guilty of a petty misdemeanor."

Section 2. Section 66-3-411 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1978, Chapter 99, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:
" 66-3-411. SPECI AL REGI STRATI ON PLATES- - PRI SONERS OF WAR AND SURVI VI NG SPOUSES- - SUBM SSI ON OF PROOF-- PENALTY. - -
A. The [division] department shall issue distinctive regi stration pl ates for up to two vehicles to [any] a person, or to the survi ving spouse of any deceased person, who was hel d as a prisoner of war by an enemy of the United States during [ any] an armed conflict, upon the submi ssion by the person or survi ving spouse of proof satisfactory to the [ division] department that he was hel d as a prisoner of war by an enemy of the United States during a period of armed conflict or that he is the surviving spouse of such a person. No fee, including the regul ar regi stration fee . 125196. 1
appl icable to the passenger motor vehicle, if any, shall be collected for issuance of a special registration plate pursuant to this section.
B. No person shall fal sel y represent himself to have been hel d as a prisoner of war or to be the surviving spouse of a prisoner of war so as to be eligible to be issued special registration pl ates pursuant to this section when he in fact was not hel d as a prisoner of war or when he in fact is not the survi ving spouse of a prisoner of war.
C. [Any] A person who vi ol ates the provisions of Subsection B of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor."

Section 3. Section 66-3-412 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1979, Chapter 299, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:
"66-3-412. SPECI AL REGI STRATI ON PLATES- - ONE HUNDRED PERCENT DI SABLED VETERANS- - SUBM SSI ON OF PROOF-- PENALTY. - -
A. The [division] department shall issue di stinctive regi stration pl ates for up to two vehicles to [any] a person who is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States, as defined in Section 28-13-7 NMSA 1978, and was one hundred percent di sabled while serving in the armed forces of the United States, upon the submissi on by the person of proof satisfactory to the [ division] department that he was one hundred percent di sabled while serving in the armed forces of the United States. No fee, incl udi ng the regul ar regi stration fee applicable to the passenger motor vehicle, if . 125196. 1
any, shall be collected for issuance of a special regi stration pl ate pursuant to this section. [Any] A person el igible for a special regi stration pl ate pursuant to this section and al so el i gi ble for one or more special regi stration pl ates pursuant to Sect i ons 66-3-406, 66-3-409 and 66-3-411 NMSA 1978 shall be issued only one special registration ate of his choice.
B. No person shall fal sel y represent himself to have been one hundred percent di sabled while serving in the armed forces of the United States so as to be eligi ble to be issued special registration pl ates pursuant to this section when he in fact was not one hundred percent di sabl ed while serving in the armed forces of the United States.
C. [Any] A person eligi ble for a special regi stration plate under this section shall only be el igible for one such plate.
D. [Any] A person who vi ol ates the provisions of Subsection $B$ of $t h i s$ section is guilty of a misdemeanor."

Section 4. Section 66-3-415 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1989, Chapter 162, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
"66-3-415. SPECI AL REG STRATI ON PLATES FOR PEARL HARBOR SURVI VORS. - -
A. The [division] department shall issue di stinctive regi stration pl ates [indicating that the fecipient] for up to two vehicles to a person who is a survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor if that person submits . 125196. 1
satisfactory proof to the [ division] department indi cating that the person:
(1) was a nember of the United States armed forces on Decenber 7, 1941;
(2) recei ved an honorable di scharge fromthe United States armed forces; and
(3) was on station on December 7, 1941 during the hours of 7:55 a.m to 9: $45 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$ Hawai time at Pearl Harbor, the island of Oahu, or offshore at a di stance not exceedi ng three miles.
B. The [division] department shall confirm satisfactory proof with the New Mexi co chapter of the Pearl Harbor survi vors associ ation.
C. No fee other than the regi stration fee applicable to the passenger motor vehicle, if any, shall be collected for the issuance of the distinctive regi stration pl ate pursuant to this section.
D. The reci pi ent of a di stinctive pl ate i ssued pursuant to this section shall be issued repl acement plates upon request and without charge if the plate is lost, stol en or mutilated.
E. [Any] A person el igi ble for a di stinctive registration plate pursuant to this section and al so igible for one or more special or distinctive regi stration pl ates pur suant to Secti ons 66-3-406, 66-3-409, 66-3-411, 66-3-412
and 66-3-414 NMSA 1978 shall be issued onl y one special or distinctive regi stration pl ate of the person's choice.
F. No person shall falsely represent himelf to be a survi vor of the attack on Pearl Harbor so as to be el igi ble to be issued di stinctive pl ates pursuant to this section when that person in fact is not a survivor of the attack on Pearl Har bor .
G. [Any] A person who vi ol ates the provi si ons of Subsection $F$ of $t h i s$ section is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be puni shed by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) or more than one thousand dollars $(\$ 1,000)$ or by imprisonment for a definite termless than one year or both. "

Section 5. Section 66-3-419 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1990, Chapter 46, Section 2 , as amended) is amended to read:
"66-3-419. SPECI AL REG STRATI ON PLATES FOR ARMED FORCES VETERANS. --
A. The [division] department shall issue di stinctive regi stration pl ates [indicating that the fecipient] for up to two vehicles to a person who is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States, as defined in Section 28-13-7 NMSA 1978, if that person submits proof satisfactory to the [division] department of honorable di scharge fromthe armed forces.
B. For a fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00), which . 125196. 1
shall be in addition to the regul ar motor vehicle regi stration fees, any motor vehi cle owner who is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States may apply for the issuance of a special regi stration pl ate as defined in Subsection $A$ of thi s section. No two owners shall be issued identically lettered or numbered pl ates.
C. The fifteen- dollar (\$15.00) fee provided in Subsection B of this section shall be wai ved for each regi stration period in whi ch a validating sticker is issued under the provi si ons of Section 66-3-17 NMSA 1978, in Iieu of the issuance of a special armed forces veteran pl ate.
D. Each armed forces veteran may el ect to recei ve a veteran- desi gnation decal to be placed across the top of the pl ate, centered above the regi stration number [ in lieu-of the eount y designation decal specified in Subsection H of Section 66-3-14 NMSA 1978]. Repl acement or di fferent veteran- desi gnation decal s shall be available for purchase fromthe [division] department at a reasonable charge to be set by the [director] secretary. The department shall furni sh the following veteran-desi gnation decals with the armed forces veteran pl ate to a:
(1) medal of honor reci pi ent;
(2) silver star reci pi ent;
(3) bronze star reci pi ent;
(4) navy cross reci pi ent;
(5) di sti ngui shed servi ce cross reci pi ent;
(6) ai $r$ force cross reci pi ent;
(7) ex-prisoner of war;
(8) di sabl ed vet eran;
(9) purple heart veteran;
(10) atomi c veteran;
(11) Pearl Harbor survi vor;
(12) Navaj o code tal ker;
(13) Vi et nam vet er an;
(14) Korean veteran;
(15) di sabl ed Korean vet er an;
(16) Wbrld War II veteran;
(17) Wbrld Var I veteran;
(18) Grenada veteran;
(19) Panama veteran; [ and] or
(20) Desert Storm veteran.
E. The revenue from the special regi stration
pl ates for the armed forces veter ans fee imposed by Subsection B of this section shall be di stributed as follows:
(1) seven dollars (\$7.00) of the fee collected for each registration plate shall be retained by the [division] department and is appropriated to the [ division] department for the manufacture and issuance of the regi stration plates; and
(2) ei ght dollars (\$8.00) of the fee
collected for each regi stration pl ate shall be transferred [under] pursuant to the provisions of Subsection $F$ of this section.
F. There is created in the state treasury the "armed forces veterans license fund". A portion of the fee collected for each special registration plator armed forces veterans, as provi ded in Subsection $E$ of this section, shall be transferred to the state treasurer for the credit of the fund. Expenditures fromthe fund shall be made on vouchers i ssued and si gned by the di rector of veterans' affairs upon warrants drawn by the department of finance and administration for the purpose of expanding services to rural areas of the state, incl uding Nati ve Ameri can communities and seni or citizen centers. Any unexpended or unencumbered bal ance remaining at the end of any fiscal year in the armed forces veterans license fund shall not revert to the general fund."

Section 6. EFFECTI VE DATE. - - The ef fective date of the provi si ons of this act is July 1, 1999.

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
