14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONSeventy-four million dollars
16	(\$74,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
17	department of finance and administration for expenditure in
18	fiscal year 2000 for the purpose of compensating the pueblo of
19	Zia for the unauthorized use of the Zia sun symbol as the
20	state symbol for seventy-five years. The governor shall
21	negotiate a contract with the pueblo of Zia for continued use
22	of its sun symbol. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
23	remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the
24	general fund.
