Section 3. **PROHIBITION OF PARTIAL-BIRTH ABORTIONS. - - No** person shall perform a partial-birth abortion except a physician who has determined that in his opinion the partialbirth abortion is necessary to save the life of a pregnant female:

A. because her life is endangered by a physical disorder, illness or injury, including a condition caused by or arising from the pregnancy; and

B. no other medical procedure would suffice for the purpose of saving her life.

> Section 4. CIVIL REMEDIES. --

Except as provided in Subsection B of this A. section, the following persons may bring a civil action to obtain relief pursuant to this section against a person who has violated the provisions of Section 3 of the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act:

B. A woman upon whom a partial-birth abortion has been performed may not be prosecuted for a violation of the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act or conspiracy to violate that act.

Section 6. SEVERABILITY--SECTION 3 NOT SEVERABLE. --

A. Except for Section 3 of the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act, if any part or application of that act is held invalid, the remainder or its application to other situations or persons shall not be affected.

B. If any part or application of Section 3 of the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act is held invalid, the remainder of that act or its application to other situations or persons shall be likewise invalid. Section 3 of that act is not severable.
