15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. Section 3-45-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1965,
17	Chapter 300, Section 14-46-5, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"3-45-5. CREATION OF AUTHORITY
19	A. Every city, in addition to other powers
20	conferred by the Municipal Housing Law, shall have power and
21	is [ <del>hereby</del> ] authorized, by proper resolution of its governing
22	body, to create, as an agent of such city, an authority to be
23	known as the "housing authority" of the city. The "housing
24	authority" of the city may constitute a public body corporate.
25	The city may delegate to such authority the power to

construct, maintain, operate and manage any housing project or projects of the city and may delegate to the authority any or all of the powers conferred on the city by the Municipal Housing Law.

5 **B**. When the governing body of a city adopts a resolution pursuant to Subsection A of this section, the mayor 6 7 shall appoint five persons as commissioners of the authority 8 created as agent for the city. The commissioners who are 9 first appointed shall be designated to serve for terms of one, 10 two, three, four and five years, respectively, from the date 11 of their appointment, but thereafter, commissioners shall be 12 appointed for a term of office of five years, except that all 13 vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term. [ A 14 commissioner of an authority shall not hold any other office or employment of the city for which the authority is created. ] 15 16 A commissioner shall hold office until his successor has been 17 appointed and has qualified, unless sooner removed according 18 A commissioner may serve two or more successive terms to law. 19 of office. A certificate of the appointment or reappointment 20 of any commissioner shall be filed with the clerk, and the 21 certificate shall be conclusive evidence of the due and proper 22 appointment of such commissioner. A commissioner shall 23 receive no compensation for his services for the authority in 24 any capacity, but he shall be entitled to the necessary 25 expenses, including traveling expenses, incurred in the

discharge of his duties.

Any powers delegated by a city to an authority 2 C. shall be vested in the commissioners of the authority in 3 4 office from time to time. Three commissioners shall 5 constitute a quorum of the authority for the purpose of conducting its business and exercising its powers and for all 6 7 other purposes. Action may be taken by the authority upon a vote of a majority of the commissioners present. 8 The 9 commission shall organize itself at its annual meeting each 10 even-numbered year. Any city creating a housing authority may authorize the authority to employ a secretary who shall be 11 12 executive director and who shall be removable only for cause, 13 technical experts and such other officers, attorneys, agents 14 and employees, permanent and temporary, as the authority may 15 require; to determine their qualifications, duties and 16 compensation; and to delegate to one or more of them such powers or duties as the authority may deem proper." 17
