AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATIONAL RETIREMENT; PROVIDING PAYMENTS ON
BEHALF OF CERTAIN RETIRED MEMBERS AND CERTAIN REEMPLOYED
MEMBERS WHO DIE BEFORE RECOUPING THE AMOUNT OF THEIR
CONTRIBUTIONS PLUS INTEREST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-11-26 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
Chapter 16, Section 149, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-11-26. DEATH DURING REEMPLOYMENT. -- If a member dies
during a period of reemployment following retirement pursuant
to the Educational Retirement Act, the benefits to be paid
shall be determined according to the following:

A. if the member did not elect to exercise Option
B or C pursuant to Section 22-11-29 NMSA 1978 at the time of
first retirement, the member's beneficiary or estate shall

1 receive ~~[the difference, if any, between the member's total~~
2 ~~contribution and total benefits received prior to last~~
3 ~~reemployment, plus contributions made by the member during the~~
4 ~~period of last reemployment]~~ an amount equal to the sum of the
5 member's contributions, including contributions made by the
6 member during the period of last reemployment, plus
7 accumulated interest at the average rate earned by the fund
8 during the preceding five fiscal years, less the total
9 benefits received prior to the last reemployment; or

10 B. if a retirement benefit has been paid to the
11 member pursuant to either Option B or Option C of Section
12 22-11-29 NMSA 1978 prior to reemployment, the reemployed
13 member shall be considered as retiring on the day preceding
14 the date of death, and the benefits due the surviving
15 beneficiary, computed as of that date, shall be commenced
16 effective on the date of death in accordance with the terms of
17 the option elected. "

18 Section 2. Section 22-11-29 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
19 Chapter 16, Section 152, as amended) is amended to read:

20 "22-11-29. RETIREMENT BENEFIT OPTIONS. --

21 A. Upon retirement pursuant to the Educational
22 Retirement Act, a member may elect, and such election shall be
23 irrevocable, to receive the actuarial equivalent of his
24 retirement benefit, as provided in Section 22-11-30 NMSA 1978,
25 to be effective on his retirement in any one of the following

1 optional forms:

2 (1) OPTION B. A reduced annuity payable
3 during the member's life with provision that upon the member's
4 death the same annuity shall be continued during the life of
5 and paid to the beneficiary designated by the member in
6 writing at the time of electing this option; or

7 (2) OPTION C. A reduced annuity payable
8 during the member's life with provision that upon the member's
9 death one-half of this same annuity shall be continued during
10 the life of and paid to the beneficiary designated by the
11 member in writing at the time of electing this option.

12 B. In the case of Options B and C of Subsection A
13 of this section, the actuarial equivalent of the member's
14 retirement benefit shall be computed on the basis of the lives
15 of both the member and the beneficiary.

16 C. In the event that the named beneficiary of a
17 retired member who elected Option B or C at the time of
18 retirement predeceases the retired member, the annuity of the
19 retired member shall be adjusted by adding an amount equal to
20 the amount by which the annuity of the retired member was
21 reduced at retirement as a result of the election of Option B
22 or C. The adjustment authorized in this subsection shall be
23 made as follows:

24 (1) beginning on the first month following
25 the month in which the named beneficiary of a retiree dies

1 applicable to an annuity received by a retiree who retires
2 after June 30, 1987; or

3 (2) beginning on July 1, 1987 applicable to
4 an annuity received by a retiree who retired prior to July 1,
5 1987 and otherwise qualifies for the adjustment; provided,
6 however, no adjustment shall be made retroactively.

7 D. In the event of the death of the member who has
8 not retired and who has completed at least five years' earned
9 service credit, the member shall be considered as retiring on
10 the first day of the month following the date of death, and
11 the benefits due the surviving beneficiary, computed as of
12 that date, shall, except as provided in Subsection G of this
13 section, be commenced effective on the first day of such month
14 in accordance with the terms of Option B. In lieu of the
15 provisions of Option B, the surviving beneficiary may elect to
16 receive payment of all the contributions made by the member,
17 plus interest at the rate earned by the fund during the
18 preceding fiscal year reduced by the sum of any disability
19 benefits previously received by the member, or the surviving
20 beneficiary may choose to defer receipt of the survivor's
21 benefit to whatever age the beneficiary chooses up to the time
22 the member would have attained age sixty. If the benefit is
23 thus deferred, it shall be calculated as though the member had
24 retired on the first day of the month in which the beneficiary
25 elects to receive the benefit. In the event of the death of

1 the beneficiary after the death of the member and prior to the
2 date on which the beneficiary has elected to receive the
3 beneficiary's benefit, the estate of the beneficiary shall be
4 entitled to a refund of the member's contributions plus
5 interest at the rate earned by the fund during the preceding
6 fiscal year, reduced by the sum of any disability benefits
7 previously received by the member.

8 E. In the case of death of a retired member who
9 did not elect either Option B or C and before the benefits
10 paid to him have equaled the [~~amount~~] sum of his accumulated
11 contributions to the fund plus accumulated interest at the
12 average rate earned by the fund during the preceding five
13 fiscal years, the balance shall be paid to the beneficiary
14 designated in writing to the director by the member or, if no
15 beneficiary was designated, to the estate of the member.

16 F. No benefit shall be paid pursuant to this
17 section if the member's contributions have been refunded
18 pursuant to Section 22-11-15 NMSA 1978.

19 G. In the case of death of a member with less than
20 five years' earned service credit or death of a member who has
21 filed with the director a notice rejecting the provisions of
22 Subsection C of this section, which notice shall be revocable
23 by the member at any time prior to retirement, the member's
24 contributions to the fund plus interest at the rate earned by
25 the fund during the preceding fiscal year shall be paid to the

1 beneficiary designated in writing to the director by the
2 member or, if no beneficiary was designated, to the estate of
3 the member.

4 H. Any elections of either Option B or C of
5 Subsection A of this section on file with the director by
6 members who have not retired prior to June 30, 1984 are void."
