

15	Section 1. Section 22-2-8.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1986,							
16	Chapter 33, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:							
17	"22-2-8.1. LENGTH OF SCHOOL DAYMINIMUM							
18	A. Regular students shall be in school-directed							
19	programs, exclusive of lunch, for a minimum of the following:							
20	(1) kindergarten, two and one-half hours per							
21	day or four hundred fifty hours per year;							
22	(2) grades one through six, five and one-half							
23	hours per day or nine hundred ninety hours per year; and							
24	(3) grades seven through twelve, six hours							
25	per day or one thousand eighty hours per year.

1	B. Nothing in this section precludes a local								
2	school board from setting length of school days in excess of								
3	the minimum requirements established by Subsection A of this								
4	section or from offering extended instructional hours during								
5	the regular school day, evenings or weekends to offer								
6	additional or alternative instructional programs to meet the								
7	needs of the school district.								
8	C. The state superintendent may waive the minimum								
9	length of school days in those districts where such minimums								
10	would create undue hardships as defined by the state board."
