The absentee ballot register is a public record 14 open to public inspection in the county clerk's office during regular office hours. At a minimum, the county clerk shall 15 16 have available for public inspection an updated absentee 17 ballot register during regular business hours on Tuesdays, 18 Wednesdays and Fridays. 19 D. The county clerk shall deliver to the absentee 20 board on election day a complete list of all absentee ballot 21 applicants with applicable information shown in the absentee 22 ballot register for each applicant up to noon of the day 23 preceding the election. The county clerk shall deliver a

signature roster containing the same information as the lists to the absentee board.
