## AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH; PROVIDING THAT ONLY CERTAIN LICENSED

MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS CAN PERFORM TATTOOING, SCARIFICATION OR
BODY PIERCING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

- Section 1. TATTOOING--BODY PIERCING.--
- A. Tattoos, scarification and body piercing shall be performed only by licensed medical practitioners.
  - B. For the purposes of this section:
- (1) "body piercing" means to cut, stab or penetrate the skin to create a permanent hole or opening;
- (2) "licensed medical practitioner" means a licensed physician, physician assistant, doctor of oriental medicine or nurse practitioner;
  - (3) "scarification" means cutting into the
