16	Section 1. A new section of the Public School Code is

18	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] RANDOM DRUG TESTINGSCHOOL PERSONNEL
19	A. School districts may conduct mandatory random
20	drug testing of all school personnel employed by the school
21	district or who apply for a position with the school district.
22	A school district may not recover the costs of conducting a
23	drug test from the school personnel.
24	B. A drug test shall be limited to controlled
25	substances as defined in Sections 30-31-6 through 30-31-10

1	NMSA 1978. A test for any other substance or medical
2	condition shall not be allowed pursuant to this section.
3	C. A drug test may be conducted only by a third
4	party. A school personnel member shall be required to
5	disclose to the third party the use of only those medications
6	that may affect the result of the drug test. The third party
7	shall keep the disclosure confidential and shall not disclose
8	the use of the medications or any medical conditions that the
9	third party has knowledge of to the school district.
10	D. Results from a drug test conducted pursuant to
11	this section shall not be given to a law enforcement official
12	without the consent of the school personnel member tested."
