21	"27-2B-4. APPLICATION RESOURCE PLANNING SESSION
22	INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBILITY PLANSPARTICIPATION AGREEMENT
23	REVIEW PERIODS
24	A. Application for cash assistance or services
25	shall be made to the department's county office in the county
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or district in which an applicant resides. The application shall be in writing or reduced to writing in the manner and on the form prescribed by the department. The application shall be made under oath by an applicant having custody of a dependent child and shall contain a statement of the age of the child, residence, a complete statement of the amount of property in which the applicant has an interest, a statement of all income that he and other household group members have at the time of the filing of the application and other information required by the department.

B. Application for expedited food stamps shall be made to the department's county office in the county or district in which an applicant resides. The department shall process the application for expedited food stamps within twenty-four hours after the application is made.

C. At the time of application for cash assistance and services, an applicant shall identify [household group members who are to be counted] any person who is to be included in the benefit group. Once an application is approved, the participant shall advise the department if there are any changes in the membership of the household group or benefit group.

D. No later than forty-five days after an application is filed, the department shall provide to an applicant a resource planning session to ascertain his

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immediate needs, assess financial and nonfinancial options, make referrals and act on the application.

E. No later than five days after an application is approved, the department shall provide reimbursement for child care.

F. Whenever the department receives an application for assistance, a verification and record of the applicant's circumstances shall promptly be made to ascertain the facts supporting the application and to obtain other information required by the department. The verification may include a visit to the home of the applicant, as long as the department gives adequate prior notice of the visit to the applicant.

<u>G. An applicant shall complete a job search as</u> part of the application process unless he requests a waiver.

[G.-] <u>H.</u> Within fifteen days after an application is approved, the department shall assess the education, skills, prior work experience and employability of the participant.

[H.] <u>I.</u> After the initial assessment of skills, the department shall work with the participant to develop an individual responsibility plan that:

(1) sets forth an employment goal for the participant and a plan for moving the participant into employment;

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(2) sets forth obligations of the participant

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1 that may include a requirement that the participant attend 2 school, maintain certain grades and attendance, keep his school-age children in school, immunize his children or engage 3 4 in other activities that will help the participant become and 5 remain employed; is designed to the greatest extent 6 (3) 7 possible to move the participant into whatever employment the 8 participant is capable of handling and to provide additional 9 services as necessary to increase the responsibility and 10 amount of work the participant will handle over time; 11 (4) describes the services the department may 12 provide so that the participant may obtain and keep 13 employment; and 14 (5) may require the participant to undergo appropriate substance abuse treatment. 15 16  $[H_{-}]$  <u>J.</u> The participant and a representative of the department shall sign the participant's individual 17 18 responsibility plan. 19 [J.] <u>K.</u> The participant shall also sign a 20 participation agreement that designates the number of hours 21 that he must participate in work activities to meet 22 participation standards. 23 [K.] L. The department shall review the current 24 financial eligibility of a benefit group when the department 25 reviews food stamp eligibility. . 126472. 2GJ
