## AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS; AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY DISPLAY OF AN INOPERATIVE FIREARM IN A LICENSED LIQUOR ESTABLISHMENT; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 30-7-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1975, Chapter 149, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"30-7-3. UNLAWFUL CARRYING OF A FIREARM IN LICENSED LIQUOR ESTABLISHMENTS. --

A. Unlawful carrying of a firearm in an establishment licensed to dispense alcoholic beverages consists of carrying a loaded or unloaded firearm on any premises licensed by the <u>regulation and licensing</u> department [of alcoholic beverage control] for the dispensing of alcoholic beverages except:

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1	(1) by a law enforcement officer in the
2	lawful discharge of his duties;
3	(2) by the owner, lessee, tenant or operator
4	of the licensed premises or [their] <u>his</u> agents, including
5	privately employed security personnel during the performance
6	of their duties;
7	(3) by a person in that area of the licensed
8	premises usually and primarily rented on a daily or short-term
9	basis for sleeping or residential occupancy, including hotel
10	or motel rooms; [ <del>or</del> ]
11	(4) by a person on that area of a licensed
12	premises primarily utilized for vehicular traffic or parking;
13	<u>or</u>
14	(5) for the purpose of temporary display,
15	provided that the firearm is:
16	(a) made completely inoperative before
17	it is carried onto the licensed premises and remains
18	inoperative while it is on the licensed premises; and
19	(b) under the control of the licensee
20	or an agent of the licensee while the firearm is on the
21	<u>licensed premises.</u>
22	B. Whoever commits unlawful carrying of a firearm
23	in an establishment licensed to dispense alcoholic beverages
24	is guilty of a fourth degree felony."
25	Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of

the provisions of this act is July 1, 1999.
