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sexual abuse and that the childhood sexual abuse resulted in an injury to the person, as established by competent medical or psychological testimony.

- B. As used in this section, "childhood sexual abuse" means behavior that, if prosecuted in a criminal matter, would constitute a violation of:
- $(1) \quad \text{Section 30-9-11 NMSA 1978, regarding}$ criminal sexual penetration [$\frac{\text{of a minor}}{\text{of a minor}}$];
- (2) Section 30-9-13 NMSA 1978, regarding criminal sexual contact of a minor; or
 - (3) the Sexual Exploitation of Children Act."

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
