13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

14 Section 1. STATE PARK ANNUAL PASS. --The state parks
15 division of the energy, minerals and natural resources
16 department shall sell an annual "camping pass" to residents of
17 the state that may be used for day use or camping at state
18 parks and recreation areas. The camping pass entitles the
19 bearer to admission to all state parks and recreation areas
20 for one year from the date of purchase. The camping pass may
21 be used for a maximum of fourteen days of camping in a single
22 state park or recreation area at any one time.
