16	Chapter 62, Section 22) is amended to read:
17	"27-2-12.6. MEDICAID PAYMENTSMANAGED CARE
18	A. The department shall provide for a statewide
19	managed care system to provide cost-efficient, preventive,
20	primary and acute care for medicaid recipients by July 1,
21	1995.
22	B. The managed care system shall ensure:
23	(1) access to medically necessary services,
24	particularly for medicaid recipients with chronic health
25	problems;

1	(2) to the extent practicable, maintenance of
2	the rural primary care delivery infrastructure;
3	(3) that the department's approach is
4	consistent with national and state health care reform
5	principles; and
6	(4) to the maximum extent possible, that
7	medicaid-eligible individuals are not identified as such
8	except as necessary for billing purposes.
9	C. The department may exclude nursing homes,
10	intermediate care facilities for the mentally retarded,
11	medicaid in-home and community-based waiver services and
12	residential and community-based mental health services for
13	children with serious emotional disorders from the provisions
14	of this section.
15	<u>D. Any Native American medicaid-eligible</u>
16	<u>individual residing in New Mexico:</u>
17	(1) shall be excluded by the department from
18	automatic enrollment in a managed care organization
19	<u>contracting with the state to provide health care services to</u>
20	<u>medicaid-eligible individuals, unless that individual elects</u>
21	<u>to enroll in a medicaid managed care organization, including a</u>
22	future managed care organization that would be created
23	specifically to serve Native Americans; and
24	(2) may choose to terminate his enrollment in
25	<u>a managed care organization at any time by notifying his</u>
