BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. Six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal years 1999 and 2000 in the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for planning, design and construction of an inter-generational facility for the youth and the elderly of the Mescalero Apache . 128050.1

tribe in Mescalero in Otero county; and

(2) six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for planning and design of phase 1 of new school buildings for Mescalero Apache school in Mescalero in Otero county.

\$B.\$ Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
