10 A JOINT MEMORIAL
11 EXPRESSING THE CONDOLENCES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON
12 THE DEATH OF JORDAN'S KING HUSSEIN.
13

14 WHEREAS, following World Wars I and II, which created the
15 Arab states as we know them, Jordan was a British protectorate
16 and Britain controlled the army and educated the leaders of
17 the territory; and

18 WHEREAS, in 1953 Hussein bin Talal was named king of
19 Jordan at the age of sixteen and proceeded to lead Jordan to
20 independence; and

21 WHEREAS, King Hussein was dedicated to peace and
22 progress; and

23 WHEREAS, the darkest hour of his rule was in 1967 when
24 Israel captured the west bank, resulting in thirty-one years
25 of tension, punctuated frequently by open hostility among the

1 various religious and ethnic communities in the region; and

2 WHEREAS, tense relations existed between King Hussein,
3 Israel and the Palestinian Liberation Organization for the
4 entire span of King Hussein's reign, threatening his reign and
5 middle east stability; and

6 WHEREAS, King Hussein managed to maintain an uneasy
7 peace, balancing relations with the west and with other Arab
8 states, a tricky balancing act, but essential for his
9 country's survival; and

10 WHEREAS, he continued developing close ties to the west,
11 including his marriage to Queen Noor, who was born in the
12 United States; and

13 WHEREAS, King Hussein played the role of peacemaker for
14 forty- six years and set an example for the world, balancing
15 volatile interests that could have destroyed the fabric of
16 peace at any time, and yet he survived, inspired and led;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
18 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that condolences be
19 expressed on the death of King Hussein, a dedicated and
20 devoted citizen of the world; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
22 transmitted to the Jordanian embassy in Washington.
