AN ACT

RELATING TO CORRECTIONS; REQUIRING THE CORRECTIONS DEPARTMENT TO USE A VALIDATED RISK AND NEEDS ASSESSMENT FOR ALL INMATES; REQUIRING THE USE OF EVIDENCE-BASED PRISON PROGRAMMING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 33, Article 2 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] VALIDATED RISK AND NEEDS ASSESSMENT AND EVIDENCE-BASED PROGRAMS. --

Inmates incarcerated in state correctional Α. facilities shall have their needs for prison programming assessed through the use of validated risk and needs assessments. Inmates shall be assigned to programs based on the results of the validated risk and needs assessment. corrections department shall promulgate rules and regulations

- B. The corrections department shall incorporate evidence-based programs into its prison programming as follows:
- (1) by January 1, 2016, twenty percent of inmate program funding shall be spent on evidence-based
- (2) by January 1, 2017, thirty percent of inmate program funding shall be spent on evidence-based programs:
- (3) by January 1, 2018, forty percent of inmate program funding shall be spent on evidence-based programs; and
- (4) by January 1, 2019, fifty percent of inmate program funding shall be spent on evidence-based programs.
  - C. As used in this section:
- (1) "cost beneficial" means that the cost savings realized over a reasonable period of time are greater than the costs of implementation;
- (2) "evidence-based program" means a program or practice that:
- (a) incorporates methods demonstrated to be effective for the intended population through scientifically based research, including statistically controlled evaluations
