DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Tobacco Products, 22 E-Cigarette and Nicotine Liquid Container Act: 23 "child-resistant" means a package or container Α. that is designed or constructed to be significantly difficult 24 25 for children under five years of age to open or obtain a toxic .215803.3

1 or harmful amount of the substance contained therein within a 2 reasonable time and not difficult for normal adults to use 3 properly, but does not mean a package or container that all such children cannot open or obtain a toxic or harmful amount 4 5 within a reasonable time;

> Β. "e-cigarette":

(1) means any electronic oral device, whether composed of a heating element and battery or an electronic 8 circuit, that provides a vapor of nicotine or any other substances the use or inhalation of which simulates smoking; and

(2) includes any such device, or any part thereof, whether manufactured, distributed, marketed or sold as an e-cigarette, e-cigar, e-pipe or any other product, name or descriptor; but

does not include any product regulated as (3) a drug or device by the United States food and drug administration under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act [21 U.S.C. Section 301 et seq.];

C. "minor" means an individual who is less than [eighteen] twenty-one years of age [and], but does not include an individual who is at least eighteen years of age on July 1, 2020;

Section 30-49-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, 16 Chapter 244, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read: 17 "30-49-5. REFUSAL TO SELL TOBACCO PRODUCTS, E-CIGARETTES 18 19 OR NICOTINE LIQUID CONTAINERS TO A PERSON UNABLE TO PRODUCE 20 IDENTITY CARD.--A person selling goods at retail or wholesale [may] shall refuse to sell tobacco products, e-cigarettes or 21 nicotine liquid containers to a person who is unable to produce 22 an identity card as evidence that the person is [eighteen years 23 of age or over] not prohibited from purchasing tobacco 24 25 products, e-cigarettes or nicotine liquid containers." .215803.3

SECTION 3. Section 30-49-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 244, Section 9, as amended) is amended to read:

"30-49-9. SIGNS--POINT OF SALE.--A person, firm, corporation, partnership or other entity engaged in the sale at retail of tobacco products, e-cigarettes or nicotine liquid containers shall prominently display in the place where tobacco products, e-cigarettes or nicotine liquid containers are sold and where a tobacco product, e-cigarette or nicotine liquid container vending machine is located a printed sign or decal that reads as follows:

"A PERSON LESS THAN [<del>18</del>] <u>21</u> YEARS OF AGE WHO PURCHASES A TOBACCO PRODUCT, AN E-CIGARETTE OR A NICOTINE LIQUID CONTAINER [<del>1S</del>] <u>MAY BE</u> SUBJECT TO A FINE OF UP TO \$100 <u>OR UP TO 48 HOURS</u> OF COMMUNITY SERVICE.

A PERSON WHO SELLS A TOBACCO PRODUCT, AN E-CIGARETTE OR A NICOTINE LIQUID CONTAINER TO A PERSON LESS THAN [<del>18</del>] <u>21</u> YEARS OF AGE [<del>1S</del>] <u>MAY BE GUILTY OF A CRIMINAL MISDEMEANOR AND</u> SUBJECT TO A FINE OF UP TO \$1,000."."
