HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 3

The Honorable Javier Martínez, Speaker of the House and Members of the House of Representatives State Capitol Building Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501

Honorable Speaker Martínez and Members of the House:

HOUSE BILL 1 appropriates significant funding for many vital programs that the Trump Administration has recently decided to cut or reduce, such as public broadcasting, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, and Medicaid. Therefore, New Mexicans will continue to have access to these services. While I wholeheartedly support this legislation, there are a few minor provisions that unduly constrain the Executive Department's ability to assist New Mexicans.

Accordingly, I this day SIGN and RETURN:

HOUSE BILL 1, enacted during the Fifty-Seventh Legislature, First Special Session, 2025, except the following item or items, part or parts, which I hereby veto pursuant to the authority granted to me in Article IV, Section 22 of the New Mexico Constitution:

I have vetoed the words "for" on page 3, line 8 through the end of the line. I have also vetoed the word "Any" on page 3, line 9 through the end of the line, as well as lines 10 through 11.

I have vetoed the words "for" on page 3, line 14 through the end of the line and the words and numbers "in fiscal years 2026 and 2027" on line 15. I have also vetoed the word "Any" on page 3, line 17 through the end of the line, as well as line 18.

I have vetoed the words "minimum federal" on page 4, lines 1 and 5.

I have vetoed the word "federal" on page 4, line 9. I have also vetoed the word "nutrition" on page 4, line 10 through the end of the line, as well as the word "program" on line 11.
