## **DIRECTIONS**

### **Thursday, October 15, 2009-To 1185 E. Madrid Ave, Las Cruces, NM**

From Albuquerque:

1. Head South on I-25 S/US-85 S ~218 mi
2. Take exit 6 toward Las Cruces ~0.3 mi
3. Merge onto N Main St (US-70) ~0.9 mi
4. Turn left (South) at N Solano Dr. (Spitz) ~0.6 mi
5. Take the 2nd right (West) onto E Madrid Ave ~0.2 mi

From Alamogordo:

1. Head West on US-70 W ~63.5 mi
2. Turn left (South) at N Solano Dr. (Spitz) ~0.6 mi
3. Take the 2nd right (West) onto E Madrid Ave ~0.2 mi

From Deming:

1. Head East on I-10 E ~52.4 mi
2. Take exit 135 to merge onto W Picacho Ave/US-70 ~7.1 mi
3. Turn left (North) at N Main St (US-70) ~0.8 mi
4. Turn right (East) at E Madrid Ave ~0.2 mi
5. Turn right (South) at N Solano Dr ~430 ft
6. Turn left (East) at E Madrid Ave ~0.3 mi

### **Thursday, October 15, 2009-To White Sands Missile Range (WSMR) (Depart 2:15 p.m.)**

From Las Cruces:

1. Head East on US-70 E ("Main Street") toward WSMR or Alamogordo ~25 mi
2. Take exit just after mile marker 169
3. Turn right (South) onto Owen Rd

The Las Cruces/Alamogordo Main Post Gate is approximately 3 miles after the exit.

### **Friday, October 16, 2009-To 800 1st St., Alamogordo, NM**

From White Sands Missile Range:

1. Head North on NM-213/Owen Rd ~3.6 mi
2. Take a right (West) onto US-70/WSMR Route 3570 ~43.1 mi
3. Continue on S White Sands Blvd ~1.6 mi
4. Turn right (West) at 1st St

From Albuquerque:

1. Head South on I-25 S/US-85 S ~84.5 mi
2. Take exit 139 to merge onto US-380 toward San Antonio/Carrizozo ~65.8 mi
3. Turn right (East) at Central Ave/US-54 ~58.1 mi
4. Turn left (West) at 1st St ~0.4 mi
