RE: PRELIMINARY COHORT GRADUATION RATE REPORTS: FOUR-YEAR RATES FOR 2010 COHORT AND FIVE-YEAR RATES FOR 2009 COHORT

On June 8, 2011, the New Mexico Public Education Department (PED) released reports of cohort graduation rates for all public high schools and local school districts, disaggregated for the key subgroups required by state and federal law. The PED release included:

- a press release regarding the four-year graduation rate data for the Class of 2010 (Attachment 1);
- a table entitled "4-Year Cohort Graduation Rates, Class of 2010" (Attachment 2); and
- a table entitled "5-Year Cohort Graduation Rates, Class of 2009" (Attachment 3).

The data in the two reports include the number and percentage of graduates in each cohort of entering freshmen. Data are disaggregated by gender and ethnicity, and for economically disadvantaged students, students with disabilities, and English language learners.

PED states school districts, charter schools, and state educational institutions had 10 days, from March 15 to March 25, 2011, to review and update student information used to generate the cohort graduation rates. The department says that entities may also challenge their four-year graduation rates during the adequate yearly progress (AYP) appeal period from July 21 through August 8, 2011. On its 2011 interim workplan, the LESC is scheduled to receive an August 2011 written report on AYP and cohort graduation rate results.

Four-Year Cohort Graduation Rates, Class of 2010

According to the PED data in Attachment 2, 67.3 percent of students who entered ninth grade in New Mexico public schools in fall 2006 had graduated by the end of the 2010 summer session, an increase of 1.2 percentage points over the Class of 2009. By subgroup, the four-year cohort graduation rates for the Classes of 2009 and 2010 compare as follows:

Five-Year Cohort Graduation Rates, Class of 2009

The PED data in Attachment 3 shows that 70.5 percent of students who entered ninth grade in New Mexico public schools in fall 2005 had graduated within five years, by the end of the 2010 summer session. This rate represents an increase of 4.4 percentage points over the four-year graduation rate for the 2009 cohort, and an improvement of 4.3 percentage points over the five-year graduation rate for the Class of 2008. By subgroup, the five-year graduation rates for the Classes of 2008 and 2009 compare as follows:

Background

- In 2003, LESC-endorsed legislation was enacted to require PED to issue a unique student identifier to every New Mexico public school student, enabling the department to track the progress of students from year to year and school to school within the state in the PED Student and Teacher Accountability Reporting System.
- Beginning in 2009 for the Class of 2008, PED has reported cohort graduation rates using a formula that tracks the success of students who entered high school as ninth-graders four years earlier. Previously, the department calculated graduation rates based on the percentage of students who entered 12th grade in the fall of the school year and graduated the following spring.
- In 2009, legislation was enacted to provide that a school district could count as a graduate a student who completed all the requirements for high school graduation within five years of entering ninth grade, including a final summer session.
- PED reported the first five-year cohort graduation data in April 2010 for the Class of 2008 (see Table 2, page 2 above).

Graduation Rate Highlights Need for Reform In New Mexico

Class of 2010 graduation rate shows much room for improvement

SANTA FE – The New Mexico Public Education Department (NMPED) released graduation rates for the Class of 2010 on Wednesday. The state-wide average of **67.3%** shows a slight improvement of **1.2%** over last year with 54 of New Mexico's 89 school districts reporting higher graduation rates.

"We have the students, the teachers and the potential to do so much better," said NMPED Secretary-designate Hanna Skandera. "Graduating New Mexico's young people and ensuring they have the tools to succeed in life should be at the forefront of our discussion on how we can improve our state's education system."

On Tuesday *Education Week*, a nationwide publication, released the annual *Diploma's Count* report. The report takes a look at the graduation rate for every state in the country and the District of Columbia. Using information from the Class of 2008, New Mexico ranked **49th** out of 51 (followed only by Nevada and the District of Columbia.) The report also shows New Mexico lost, on average, 71 students **per school day**. Looking at a 10 year average, New Mexico improved its graduation rate by 1.2%. The rest of the United States improved an average of 6.1% during the same time.

"And what this report makes perfectly clear is that we need reform in New Mexico as soon as possible. When we are losing 71 high school students a day, there is no time to waste because this is our future" Secretary-designate Skandera said.

To measure graduation rates, the NMPED uses what is called a 4-year cohort. This measure shows the students who enter high school and whether or not they graduate in four years. In the past, the state only calculated incoming seniors to calculate the graduation rate, leading to highly inflated numbers far detached from reality. And while the state continues to collect data on students who graduate in 5 years, that is not the accepted expectation for our children.

"Doing what's best for our children doesn't include setting a low bar. This department expects from our children and our schools for every student to graduate high school in 4 years. Higher expectations won't hurt our children" said Skandera.
