Legislative Recommendations

- Appropriate funding to expand high-quality WBL across NM
 - Stipends and training to teachers and coordinators to support internships
 - Reimbursements to employers
 - Both in- and out-of-school youth
- Support intermediaries to ensure quality and forge connections among employers, youth and schools
- Integrate WBL into comprehensive college and career pathways approach in all high schools
 - Inclusion of WBL in graduation requirements
