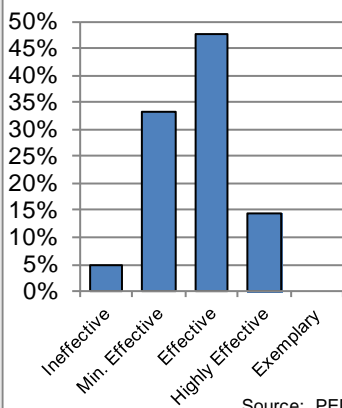

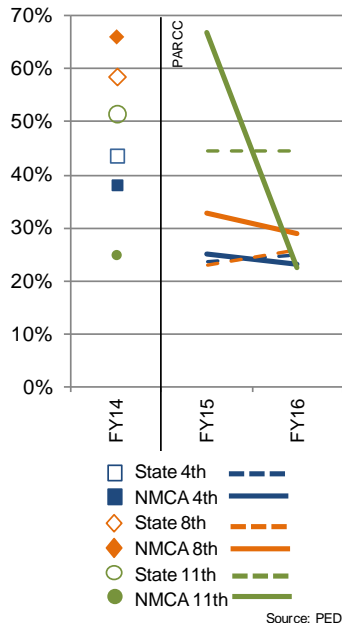

Reading Proficiency History

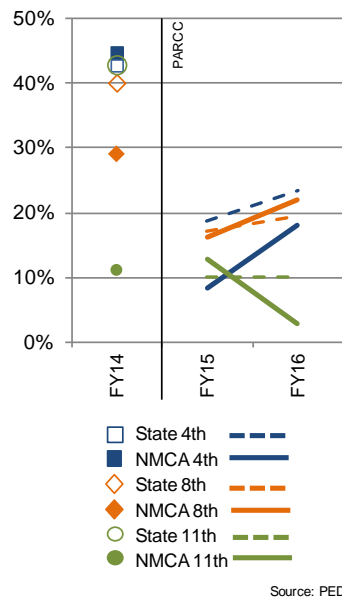

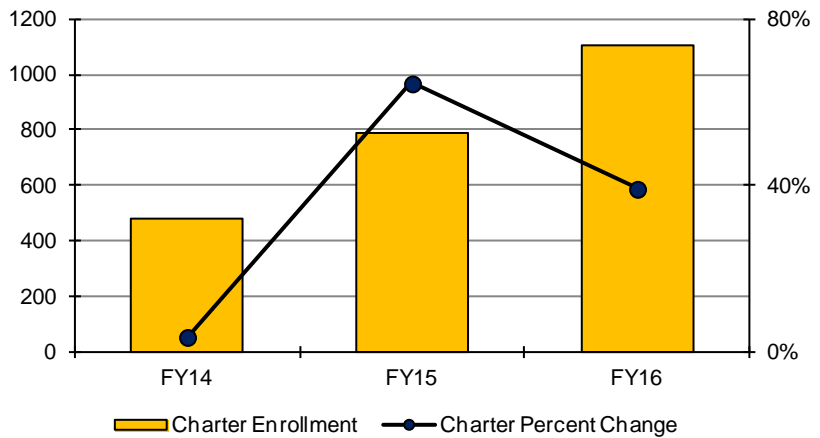
Math Proficiency History

Enrollment Data with Annual Percentage Change



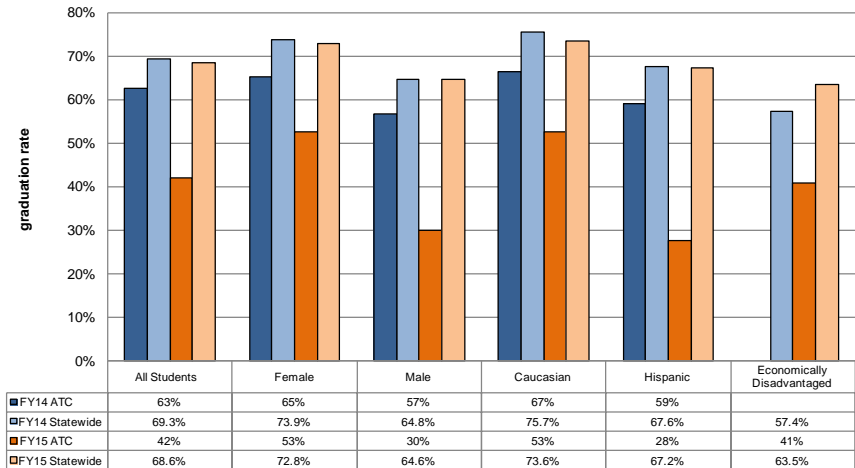
