




# Where We Are: Addressing the Educator Workforce Crisis

# Recruiting, hiring, inducting, and developing a culturally and linguistically relevant educator workforce

- Salary raises
- New licenses issued since January 1:
  - 3,570 teachers and 315 administrators
  - 72 school counselors and 40 native language certificates
- Expanding the Educator Fellows program with on-the-job training
- Providing Teacher Residency grants and Paid Student Teaching stipends.
- New Mexico's Grow Your Own pathway, Teacher Preparation Affordability Scholarships and Teacher Loan Repayment Program.



### **Vacancies Across New Mexico**




Graphic 1: Teacher Vacancies by Geographic Area (Map from: https://openbooks.ped.nm.gov/map/)

Total number of vacancies within those districts: n=627 Vacancies


# **Teacher Vacancies in High Needs Areas**





- Mentorship and ongoing supports



## **Considerations for Next Steps**

- NM legislative allocation for Educator Fellows (teachers)
  - 500 Ed Fellows
- Principal Residency
  - 50 Principals
- Continued funding for Teacher Residency
  - target is 350 residents across Educator Prep Programs
- Funding for retention efforts:
  - Professional learning opportunities
  - Micro-credentials
  - National Board Scholarships
  - Pay licensure application fee for all educators
