The History of The Golden Apple Foundation

In 1985, our founders had a dream that teachers in Illinois deserved recognition just like the actors did during the Academy Awards.

The Golden Apple Academy of Educators in Illinois was born thanks to their vision.

In 1994, Mike and Pat launched this program in New Mexico.

Both organizations continue to honor outstanding educators.



Beginning in 1989, Golden Apple in Illinois also began recruiting, preparing and supporting those who will teach in the neediest schools.

Golden Apple Teacher Preparation Programs recruit aspiring educators to return to teach in their communities and who stay.

Scholars

- Launched in 1989 in Illinois; 2022 in New Mexico
- For undergrad students

Statewide **undergraduate teacher preparation** program focused on PreK-12 schools-of-need, in partnership with higher education

Entry points

High School seniors through sophomores in college.

Accelerators

- Launched in 2020
- For career changers

15-month **residency** and PreK-12 post-bacc **licensure program**, in partnership with higher education, to prepare teachers for targeted partner school districts

Entry points

Seniors attending Illinois universities who are not on a teaching pathway, and career-changers who hold bachelor's degrees

Golden Apple Scholars reflect the diversity of the students they serve

82% of Scholars made the Dean's List in 2021

82% of Scholars for the last 3 years of Scholar graduates earned college degrees within six years Nationally, ~20% of public school educators are teachers of color

> The national 6-year graduation rate for first-generation college students is 11%


82% of Scholars



Scholar Institutes (SI)

- We host SI every summer Scholars are with GA
- Paid professional development (starts at \$2000, goes up \$500 each summer)
- 1-3 weeks in duration
- Learn from award-winning teachers
- Meet and develop connections with future teachers from across New Mexico
- Work in summer programs in Scholars' communities







Our Secret Sauce = Scholar Institutes + Mentoring

- Additional classroom hours (50/summer)
- Support Network of peer educators
- Hands-on, modeled teacher activities
- Regular **peer feedback** (warm/cool)
- **Exposure** to hometown administrators/educators
- Learning of local schools' policies/practices
- Interviewing practice with current administrators

- SI 4 led by mentor teachers
- In-person, **personalized mentoring** by Danielson trained/recognized teachers
- Feedback to help reflect on their practice and improve teaching


