

Documentation Necessary for Teacher Evaluation

- 4 Domains (1-4)
- Each *Domain* is broken into sections with letters to represent each section. (ex. A-F)
- Each *Section* has 5 *Levels of Performance* ranging from ineffective through exemplary.
- Each *Level of Performance* has several criteria points.
- The *Criteria Points* below are counted from Effective through Exemplary without counting those for Ineffective and Minimally Effective.
 - Administrators begin their evaluation with level 3 (effective).
- Every criteria point for each Level of Performance must be documented or the next lower Level of Performance is awarded.
