# DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES PLANNING COUNCIL (DDPC) BUDGET PROGRAMS

#### Office of Guardianship (OOG)

- FY20 Actual
  - \$4,454,100 General Fund
- FY21 Operating
  - \$4,490,000 General Fund
- FY22 Approved Request\*
  - \$4,261,900 General Fund
- FY22 Alternative Adjusted Requests\*
  - \$5,586,400 Wait List Reduction
  - \$5,205,400 No Wait List Reduction

### **GUARDIANSHIP SERVICES**

- Professional Legal Services
  - Approximately \$2,200 per guardianship case
  - Contractors
    - Petitioning attorneys
    - Guardians ad litem
    - Court visitors

- Professional Guardian Services
  - Probate Code guardians
    - \$325 per month per case
    - Indefinite appointment
    - 990 cases (October 2020)
  - Treatment guardians
    - \$85 per month per case
    - 6-12 month appointment
    - 435 cases (FY21 Q1 average)

### **GUARDIANSHIP SERVICES WAIT LIST**

#### **Wait List**

- Halted new case processing in January 2020
- In FY21, recalled 15 cases already in process (from applications dated 9/26/19 and later)
- II5 on wait list at end of FY20
- 217 on wait list as of November 12, 2020
  - 145 professional guardian cases
  - 72 family guardian cases

## The wait list almost doubled in the first quarter of FY21.

#### FY20 Cases

- 982 total protected persons at end of FY20
- 129 new professional guardian cases
- 86 new family guardian cases

### FY21 Cases

- 990 total protected persons as of 10/31/20
- 36 new professional guardian cases
- 13 new family guardian cases

# GUARDIANSHIP NEW CASE ASSIGNMENTS

- Emergency cases
- Priority cases
  - Adult Protective Services
  - Military veteran
  - Jackson lawsuit class member
  - Foley lawsuit referral
- Family guardian cases

- Deaths of protected persons
  - FY20 total 65 deaths
  - FY21 Q1 28 deaths
     (compared to 12 deaths in FY20 Q1)
- Supported Decision Making & other alternatives to guardianship

# CONSEQUENCES OF FAILING TO MEET GUARDIANSHIP NEEDS

- Harm to the health, safety, and protection of at-risk New Mexicans
- Litigation exposure
- Loss of professional guardian contractors & subsequent inability to provide future services
- Loss of credibility with the courts
- Rapidly growing wait list

### GUARDIANSHIP FUNDING CHALLENGES

- OOG Contracts
  - FY20 Actual \$4,816,489
  - FY21 Operating \$4,601,000
  - FY21 shortfall \$250,000
  - FY22 shortfall (wait list reduction) \$1,062,800
  - FY22 shortfall (no wait list reduction) \$681,800

- OOG Fund Balance
  - FY20 Revenue \$564,000
  - FY21 Revenue \$500,400
  - Current fund balance less than \$50,000
- State Board of Finance Grant
  - FY20 Revenue \$204,375
