

Redoubling Our Commitment

If our Criminal Legal System is failing to keep our communities safe, we recognize that we have an obligation to challenge it. As prosecutors, we regularly review accumulating caseloads to determine which cases could be declined, addressed with plea agreements and diversion options to appropriate resources.

Trends

Crime and homicides have increased in Doña Ana County from 20 homicides in 2021 to **26 in 2022**. Numbers of Juvenile offenders have decreased in 2022, (attributed to kids back in school). The trauma from shootings, both fatal and non-fatal harm entire families, neighborhoods, communities, and impact Economic Development. The return of Grand Jury has assisted and supported our caseload management. Mental Health resource infrastructure is inadequate to support the growing number of defendants needing services.




We have a genuine commitment to public safety and concern for the most impacted communities we serve that requires us to evaluate the legal sufficiency of evidence in individual cases. It is our job to constantly perform this analysis, even if the results are difficult and uncomfortable.

Innovative Caseload Resolutions

Case resolution 'Track' program will be introduced into the 3rd Judicial District within this fiscal year.

The New Mexico Supreme Court pilot track system utilizes a systematical approach to evaluate each case at intake by determining if the case is considered a Track 1 – Low-level, simple case, Track 2- Cases with intermediate complexity and Track 3 applies to the egregious complex cases. The implementation of this order will set different tracks or timelines for cases brought before the court, with a goal of increasing efficiency and expediency.

The Third Judicial DA Byers has been instrumental in reviewing and detailing the proposed language for the Track program discussion with the NM Supreme Court. These changes coincide as part of an ongoing, collaborative effort to address Court case delay.



Escalation of Crime

Arrest and charging data show how a small number of repeat offenders is responsible for a high percentage of criminal activity perpetuated by Pre-Trial Detention release conditions.

Attorney Retention

Attrition Rate is still persistent.




