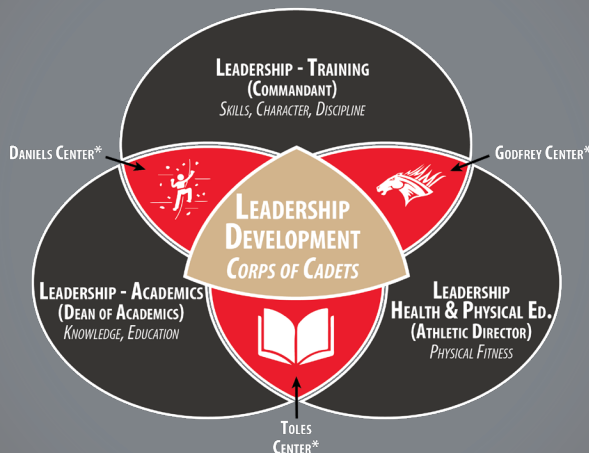

- The only state-supported co-educational military boarding school in the nation offering an integrated four-year college preparatory high school and university parallel transferable junior college.



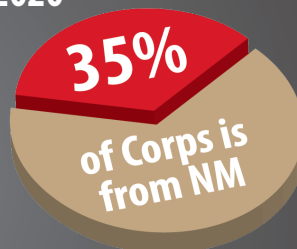
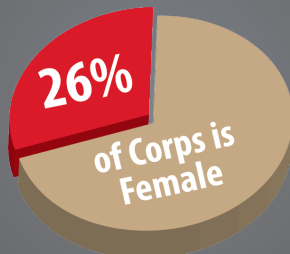
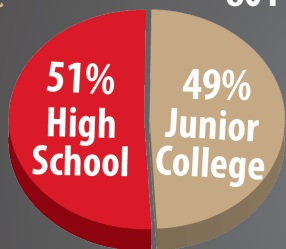
## ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

801 TOTAL ENROLLMENT FOR FALL 2020

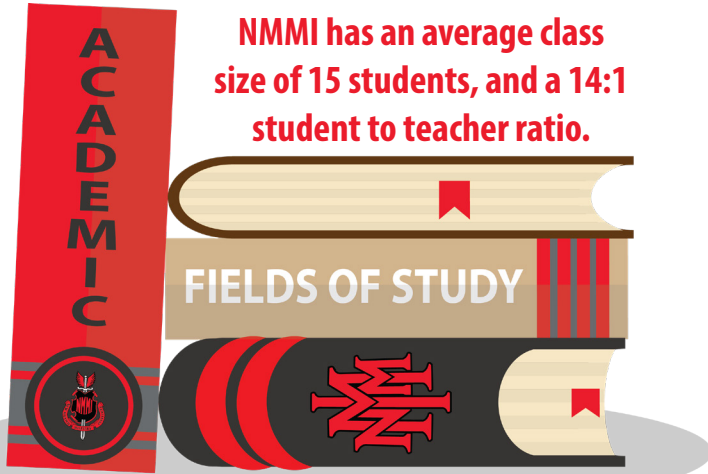
