17	SECTION 1. Section 30-1-8 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1963,
18	Chapter 303, Section 1-8, as amended) is amended to read:

1 for a third or fourth degree felony, within five Β. 2 years from the time the crime was committed; for a misdemeanor, within two years from the 3 C. 4 time the crime was committed; for a petty misdemeanor, within one year from D. 5 the time the crime was committed; 6 7 Ε. for any crime against or violation of Section 51-1-38 NMSA 1978, within three years from the time the crime 8 9 was committed: F. for a felony pursuant to Section 7-1-71.3, 10 7-1-72 or 7-1-73 NMSA 1978, within five years from the time the 11 12 crime was committed; provided that for a series of crimes involving multiple filing periods within one calendar year, the 13 14 limitation shall begin to run on December 31 of the year in which the crimes occurred; 15 G. for an identity theft crime pursuant to Section 16 30-16-24.1 NMSA 1978, within five years from the time the crime 17 was discovered; 18 H. for trafficking controlled substances that 19 20 amounts to a first degree felony pursuant to Section 30-31-20 NMSA 1978, within six years from the time the crime was 21 committed; 22 [H.] I. for any crime not contained in the Criminal 23 Code or where a limitation is not otherwise provided for, 24 within three years from the time the crime was committed; and 25 .221278.2
