15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted
17	to read:
18	"[NEW MATERIAL] OPERATING A CHOP SHOPPENALTY
19	A. Any person who knowingly owns, operates,
20	maintains or controls a chop shop or conducts operations in a
21	chop shop is guilty of a third degree felony.
22	B. As used in this section:
23	(1) "chop shop" means any building, lot,
24	facility or other structure or premises where one or more
25	persons engage in receiving, concealing, destroying,

electric power obtained from batteries or from overhead trolley

- (4) "vehicle" means every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, including any frame, chassis, body or unitized frame and body of any vehicle or motor vehicle, except devices moved exclusively by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.
- C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to preclude a claim for racketeering made pursuant to the Racketeering Act."
