Programs

We provide free experiential learning fetime learners in an

opportunities for youth, young adults, and lifetime learners in an array of focuses, such as storytelling and scriptwriting, safety, set-iquette, and grip equipment, making music videos with iPads, prop making and fabrication, set building and painting, assistant camera intensives, VR & AR content production, and documentary fundamentals. All of our trainings are taught by film and tv professionals from locals IATSE 480 & 600, ADG 800, and SAG-AFTRA. In addition, we facilitate mentorships, internships, and job opportunities with key professionals on current film and tv productions.



Communities

Stagecoach Foundation provides both in-house training in our Set & Prop House and incommunity training to provide access to opportunities of hands-on training and workforce development across the state within indigenous and rural communities. Stagecoach students predominantly come from the Institute of American Indian Arts, Santa Fe Indian School and Santa Fe public schools, Santa Fe Community College, University of New Mexico, Central New Mexico Community College, and local Pueblo communities.
