AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT STRUCTURE; REPEALING THE INTERTRIBAL CEREMONIAL ACT; TRANSFERRING FUNCTIONS OF THE INTERTRIBAL CEREMONIAL OFFICE AND INTERTRIBAL CEREMONIAL BOARD TO THE TOURISM DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. REPEAL.--Sections 9-15C-1 through 9-15C-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2005, Chapter 219, Sections 1 through 5, as amended) are repealed.

SECTION 2. TEMPORARY PROVISIONS--TRANSFERS.--

A. On the effective date of this act, all functions, appropriations, money, records, furniture, equipment and other property of the intertribal ceremonial office and the intertribal ceremonial board are transferred to the tourism department.

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B. On the effective date of this act, all contractual obligations of the intertribal ceremonial office or the intertribal ceremonial board are binding on the tourism department.

C. On the effective date of this act, all references in the law or rule to the intertribal ceremonial office or the intertribal ceremonial board are deemed to be references to the tourism department.
