Examples include NMSU Agricultural Experiment Station and Cooperative Extension Service.</li> <li>Chapter 21 Article 13 (community colleges) and Chapter 21 Article 14 (branch community colleges) did not require express legislative creation of a campus until 1998 (§ 21-13-4.2 NMSA 1978 and § 21-14-4.2 NMSA 1978).</li> <li>Not listed above are cooperative instructional programs offered on community college campuses. Examples: SJC campus (UNM, NMSU, ENMU, NMHU courses); SFCC campus (UNM, NMHU courses).</li> <li>"Learning Centers" are not campuses, but rather cooperative instructional sites (see § 21-16A-1 through § 21-16A-8 NMSA 1978).</li> <li>See 5.3.12 NMAC for definition of "campus boundaries".</li> </ol>
