SUBPOENA ISSUANCE

Additional Subpoena's Issued Today:

- **NM Department of Workforce Solutions** — employment records to identify every person who worked at Zorro Ranch, especially pre-2009, where the email record goes dark.
 - **NM Department of Public Safety** (follow-up) — the complete file on the Aug. 2018 State Police firearms-theft call, and any other State Police matter touching the ranch.
 - **NM Taxation & Revenue Department** — payroll, withholding, and tax records for the web of Zorro entities and their workers.
 - **Ten Thousand Waves** — records of the referral pipeline that sent massage therapists to the ranch, documented in FBI interviews, phone records, and charge statements.
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FROM DOCUMENTS TO PEOPLE

- **The subpoenas built the foundation** — an objective narrative rooted in records. Now we go after what and who it points to.
 - **Next steps include**, our council reaching out to individuals -both named and unnamed- in this report for interviews and depositions — voluntarily where possible, by compulsory process where necessary.
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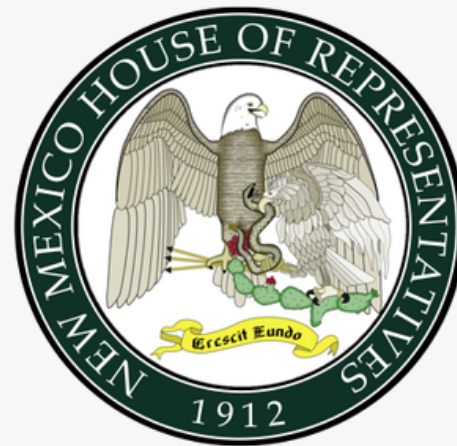
THE ROAD FORWARD

- **Now–September:** witness interviews and depositions begin, subpoena enforcement where refused
- **Financial-records analysis**
- **Ranch site inspection** with the current owners cooperation.
- **December 31, 2026: final report** — procedures, findings, conclusions, and recommendations, including 2027 legislation.
