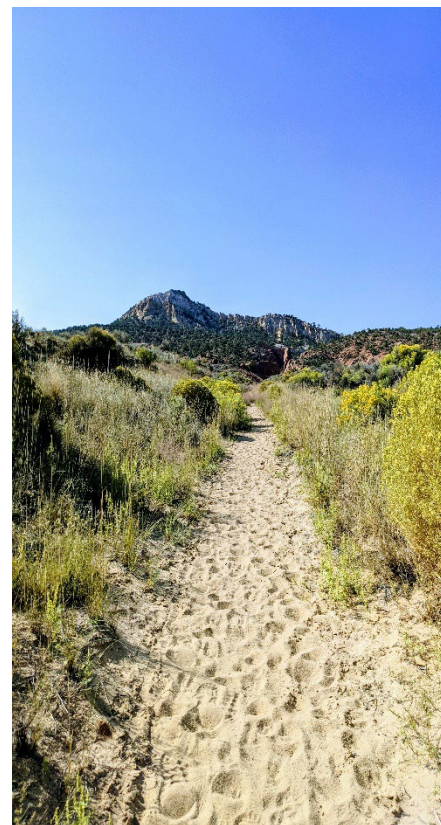




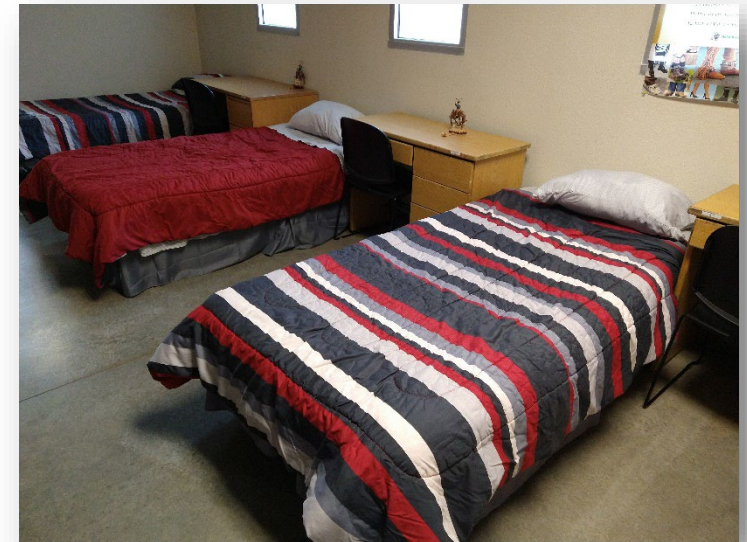
Four Corners Detox Recovery Center

Program Description

- A division of Santa Fe Recovery (2005) opened December 28, 2020
- CARF Accredited since 2007
- 45 bed capacity – genders housed separately
- Medical Detox 5-7 days
- 30 day Residential
- All NM insurance accepted
- 100% voluntary treatment
- Emphasis on community reintegration and long-term recovery
- Staff include RNs, EMTs, CPSW, LCSW; offsite MD



Medical Detox

- 15 beds
- Medications are used to treat withdrawal and other medical conditions
- Schedule 5 days a week, 7am-8pm with more recreation time on weekends
- Receive medical care, counseling, and case management
- Detox units are monitored by 24/7 support staff

Short-Term Residential

- 30 day treatment
- June 24, 2020 implemented
- 30 beds
- Programming is co-ed
- Activities Monday – Friday, 7am – 8P
 - Optional classes like worship services, Acudetox, parenting group
 - Traditional Healers & Navajo Wellness Groups
- Mandatory therapy groups

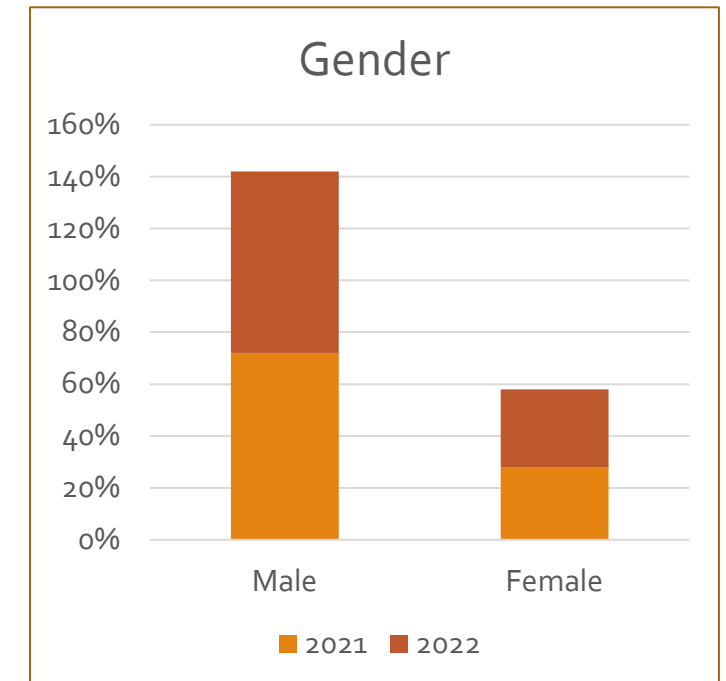
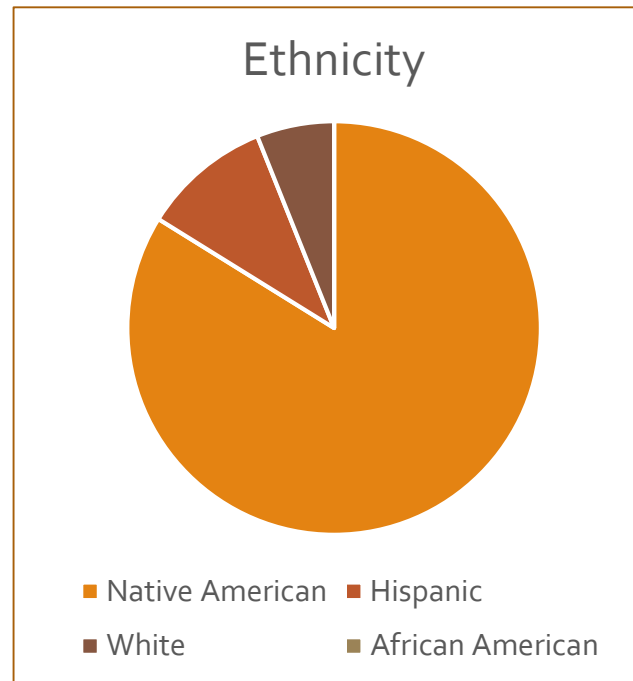
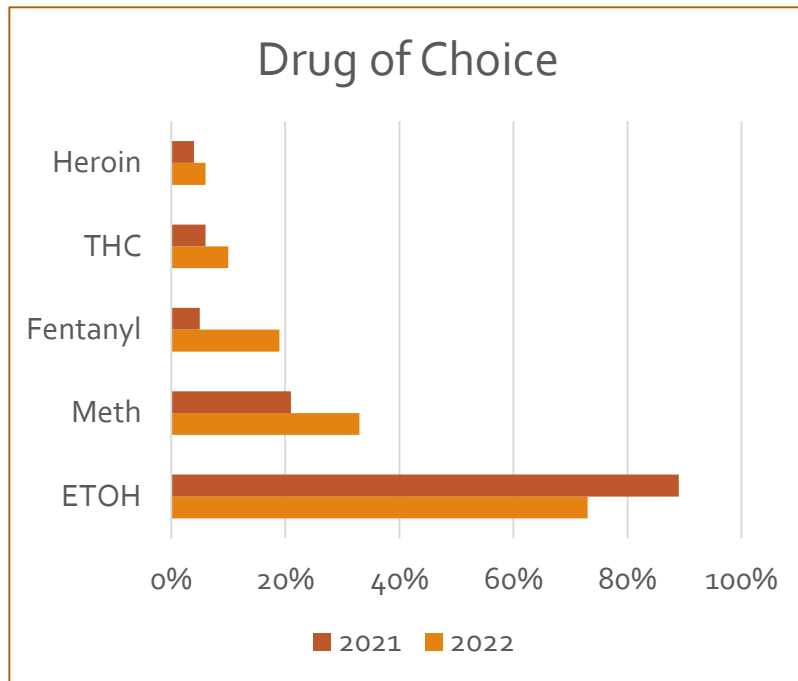
344 Total Residential Intakes



Informative Numbers

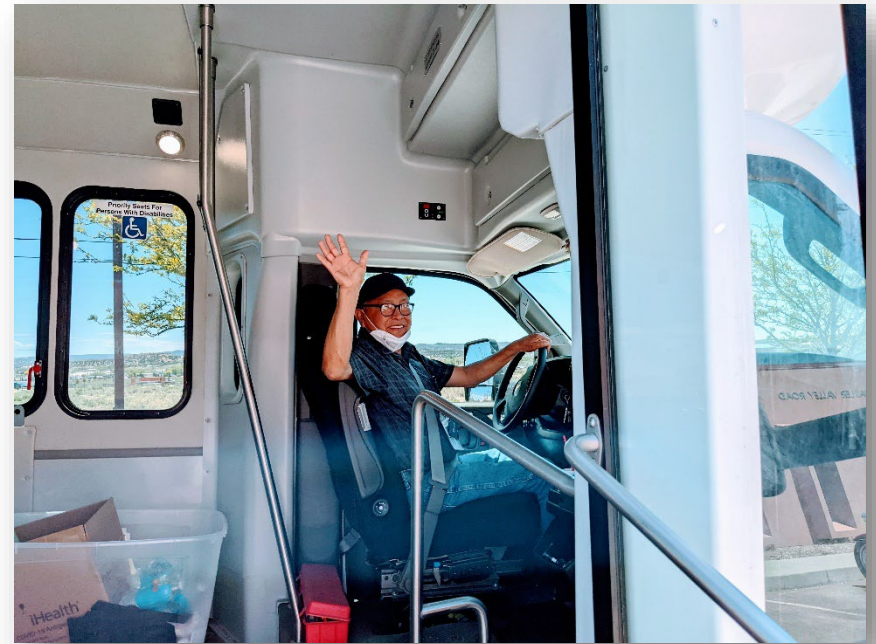
49% of clients are residents of the Navajo Nation

32% of clients are ages 36-45

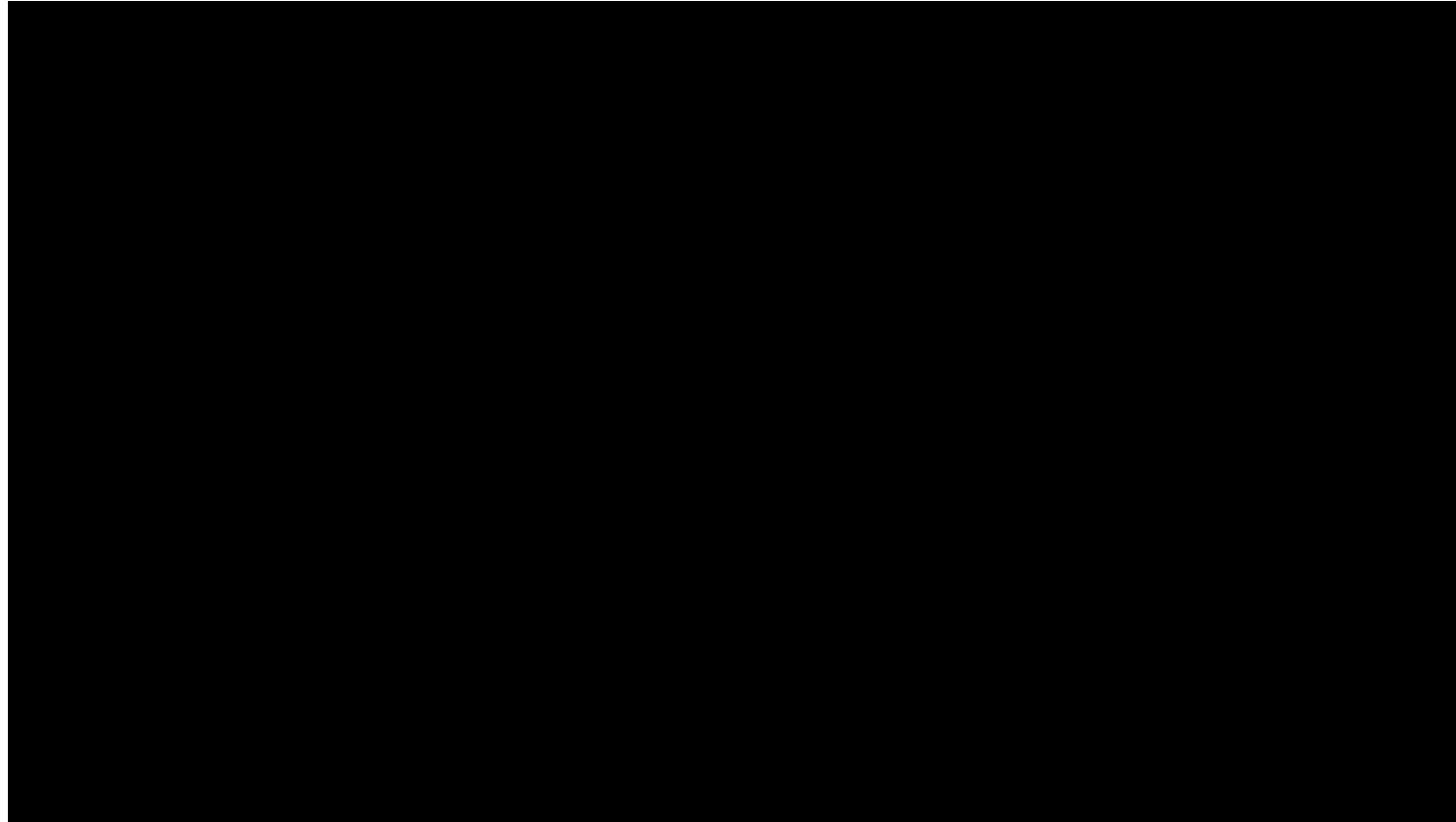


Initiatives

- Street Outreach
 - Funded by 2 HRSA Health Resources and Services Administration
 - Outreach Coordinator and 3 Street Outreach Workers
 - Formal partnerships with GIMC, RMCHCS, NMDOH, and Hozho Center
- Recovery Garden
 - In collaboration with the Gallup McKinley County Community Pantry north side of the pantry is ours to build
 - Honoring those in recovery, those we've lost due to substance use, those still working on recovery, those in active use, and their loved ones
- High Utilizer Group
 - At the request of physician's at GIMC teamed up for a multidisciplinary meeting that looks at those that have high use of the emergency department and how to better assist them
- Littlelobe, Inc. VOCA Project
 - SF based company traveled to Gallup location to create 4 short films focusing on indigenous females with young children, are pregnant or of childbearing age who suffer from substance use disorder
- Wellness Wednesday
 - Supporting staff wellness through exercise and self care activities
- Intensive Outpatient Program
