



Priority of Shiprock Associated Schools, Inc.

Shiprock Associated Schools, Inc. (SASI) is considered a hidden gem of Shiprock, located behind the Northern Navajo Medical Center in Shiprock, NM. SASI's provides Pre-K to 12th grade education at the FACE Program, Atsa Biyaazh Community School, and at Northwest Middle/High School. The school also has a residential program under construction that provides housing for grades 7th to 12th grade students. In providing this education, SASI is challenged with the lack of providing employee-housing opportunities to any of our staff members. This continues to be an impact because it hinders the living arrangements for our employees.

We are advocating for funding to help us obtain 30 Employee Housing opportunities for our employees of Shiprock Associated Schools, Inc. Currently, all of our employees have to travel from the surrounding communities of Farmington, Cortez, Gallup, Crystal and other remote locations from the Navajo Nation that maybe more than 50 miles one way. Cost of living is always a factor that our employees face when they have to rent from one of the nearby towns, plus the cost of gas and travel distant for some. This often plays a factor in why we lose employees because of this high cost of living and the lack of employee housing. We are seeking support in having funds provided to allow SASI the opportunity to providing employee housing on our campus.
