

Financial Impact of a 1% Census Undercount in New Mexico's Tribal Communities

- Each New Mexican not counted in the Census will result in approximately \$3,700 dollars in lost federal funding each year for the next ten years. ¹
- Affected programs would include Medicaid, Indian Housing Block Grants, Urban Indian Health Services, Native American Employment and Training, SNAP, Head Start/Early Head Start and hundreds of other federal programs.
