Legislative Priority: 2

Project Description: To plan, design, construct, and provide FFE for a new nursing home located in the Pueblo of Laguna

ICIP Inclusion: Yes / 2028-002

Project Impact: The Laguna Rainbow nursing home is a regional facility, serving 72,000 residents of Cibola County, including roughly 8,500 tribal citizens/residents

Total Project Cost	\$45,698,446
Funding to Date	\$198,000 (ALTSD Capital Outlay 2023) \$2,000 (ALTSD Capital Outlay 2023) \$170,000 (TIF 2023) \$370,000 (POL CIP 2025) \$370,000 ((ALTSD Capital Outlay 2026)
Funding Needed	\$44,588,446

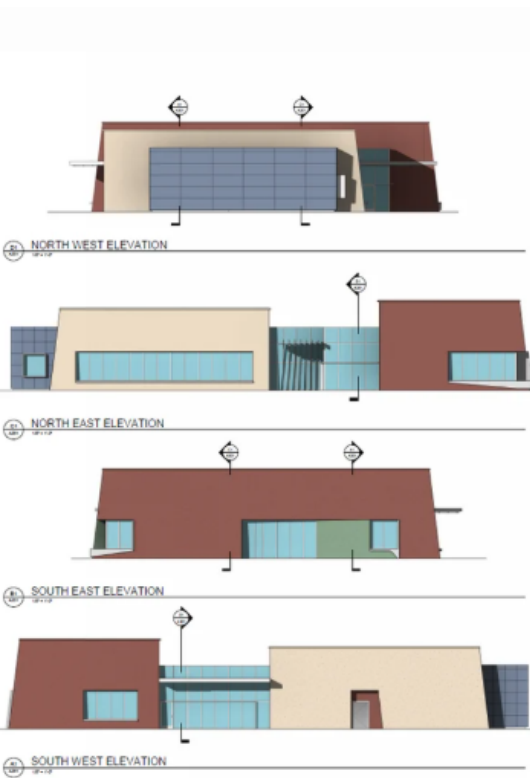

POL NETWORK OPERATIONS CENTER

Pueblo of Laguna

Legislative Priority: 7

Project Description: Construct the POL Network Operations Center (NOC), the facility needed to operate, monitor, maintain, and secure the Pueblo-owned FTTP network

ICIP Inclusion: Yes / 2028-007

Project Impact: Supports reliable broadband for Pueblo homes and essential services, including government, public safety, education, telehealth, employment, and economic activity. The NOC will serve as the permanent operational hub for the Pueblo’s FTTP network, supporting 26 million in broadband investments serving about 1,400 homes.

Total Project Cost	\$15,077,308
Funding to Date	\$500,00 (NTIA EDG)
Funding Needed	\$14,747,308
