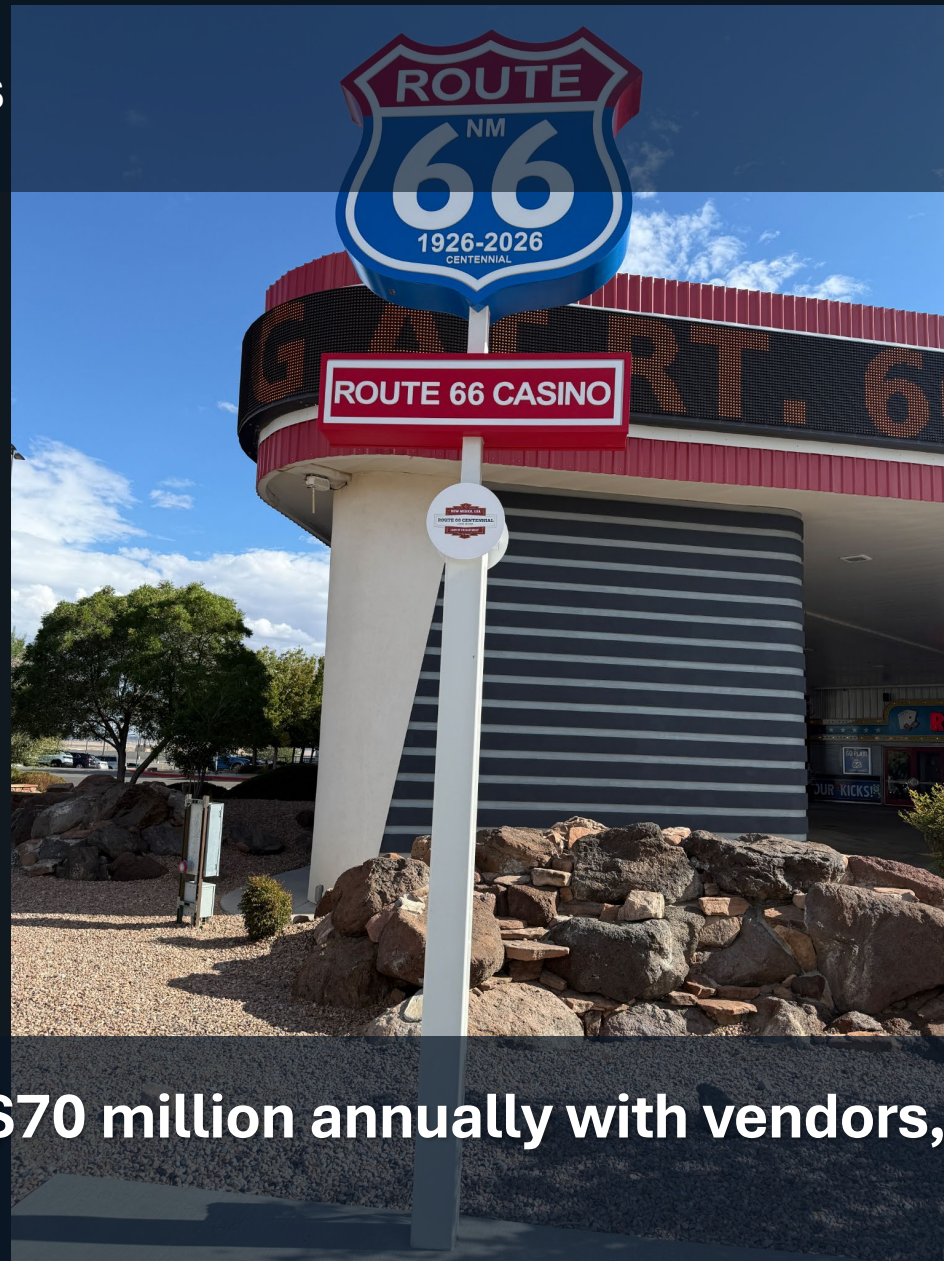
LDC contributes more than \$41 million each year in wages & employer benefits

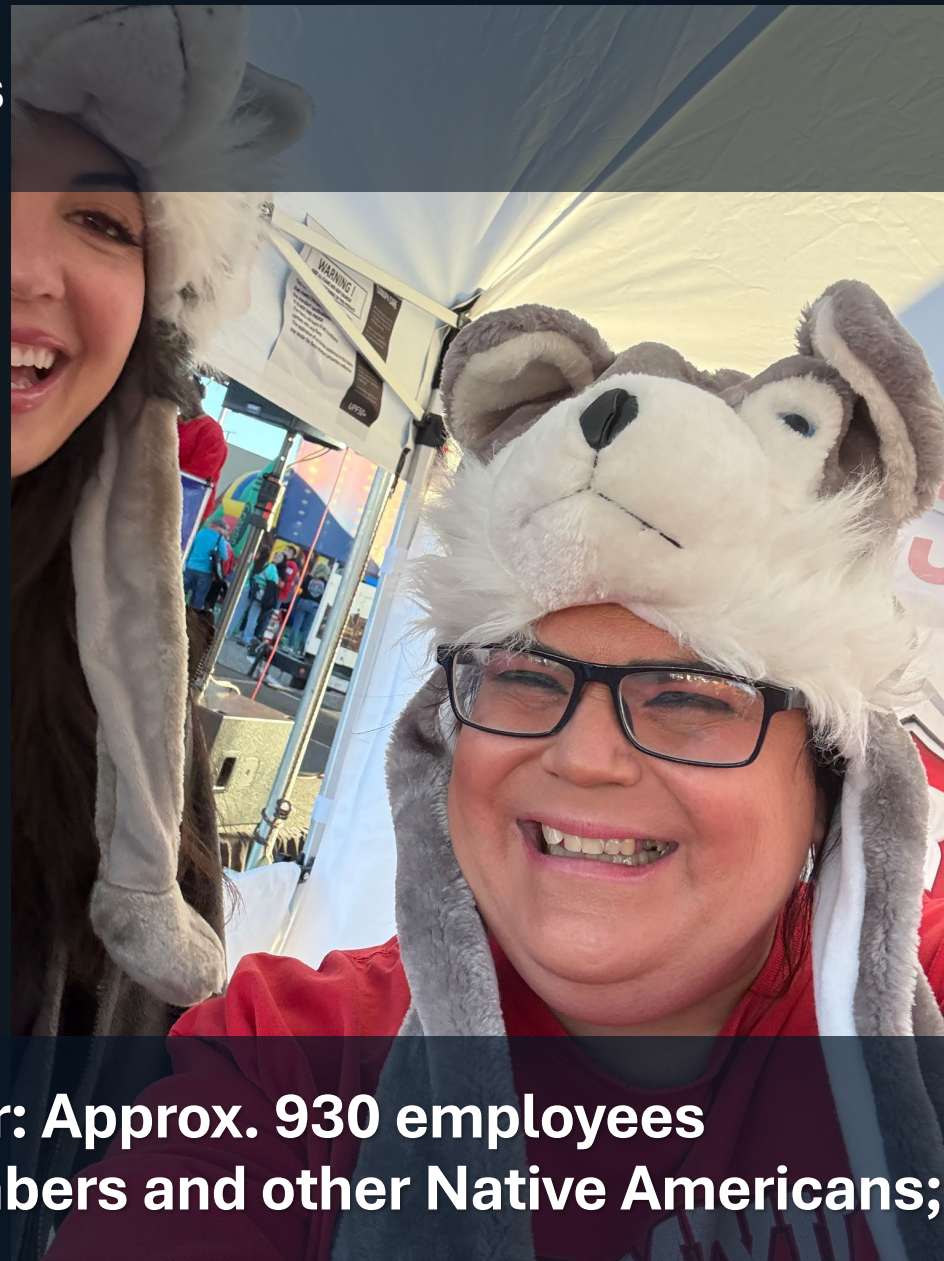
LDC spends more than \$70 million annually with vendors, contractors, and suppliers

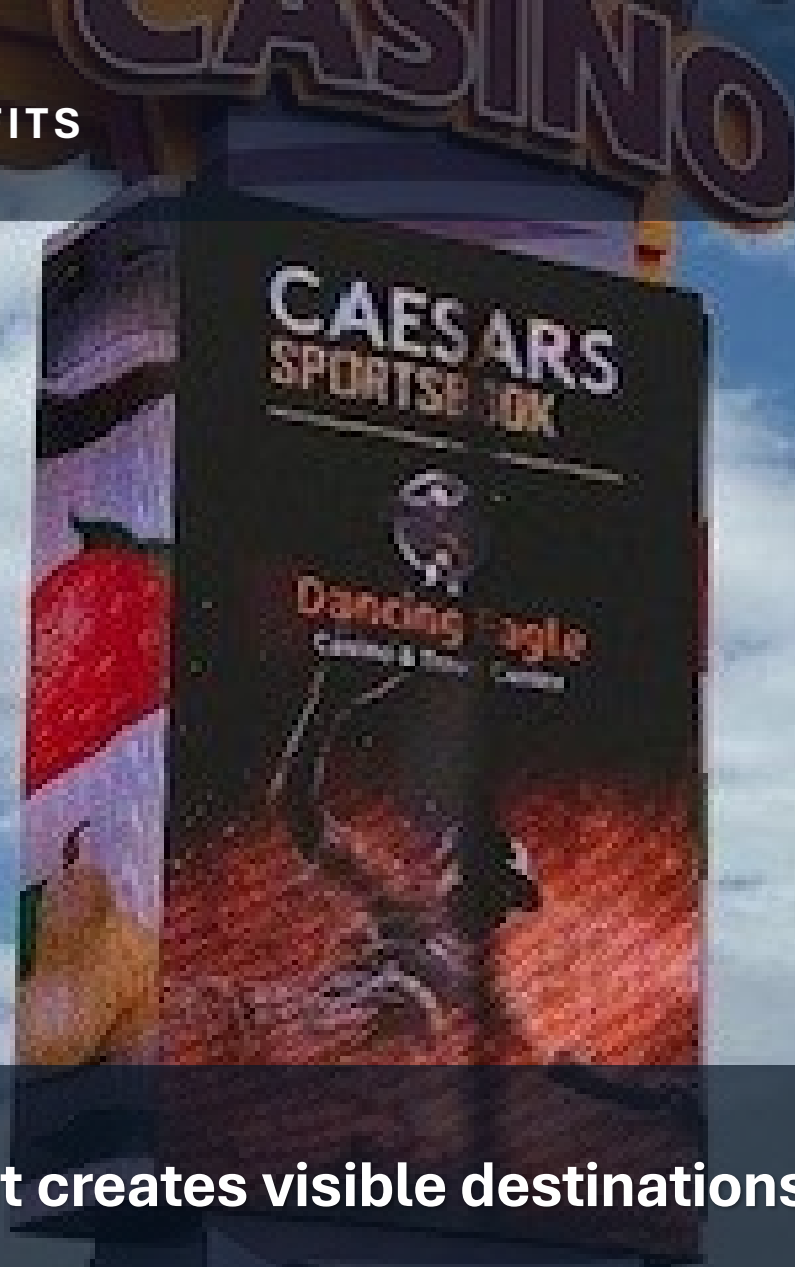

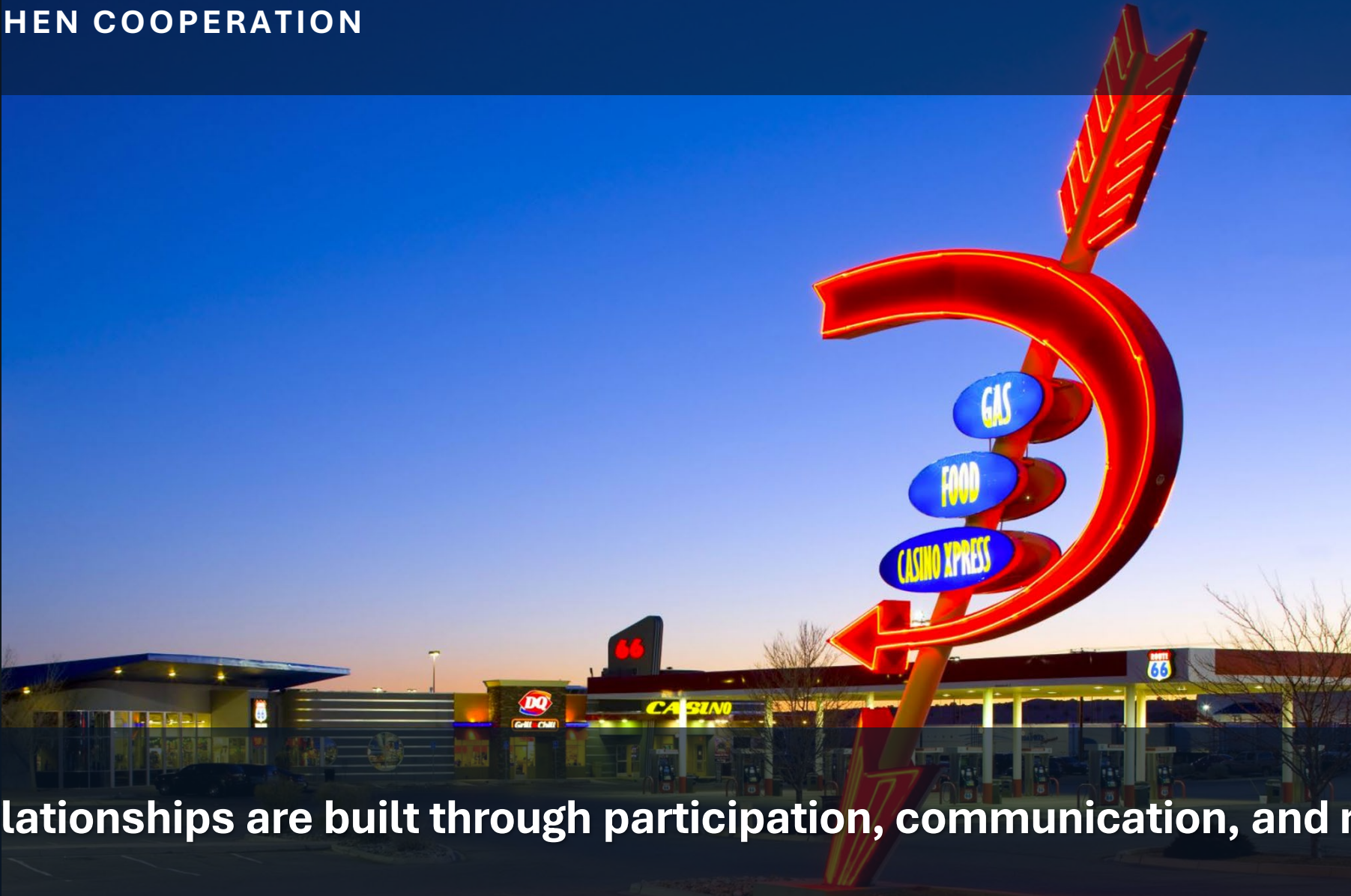
