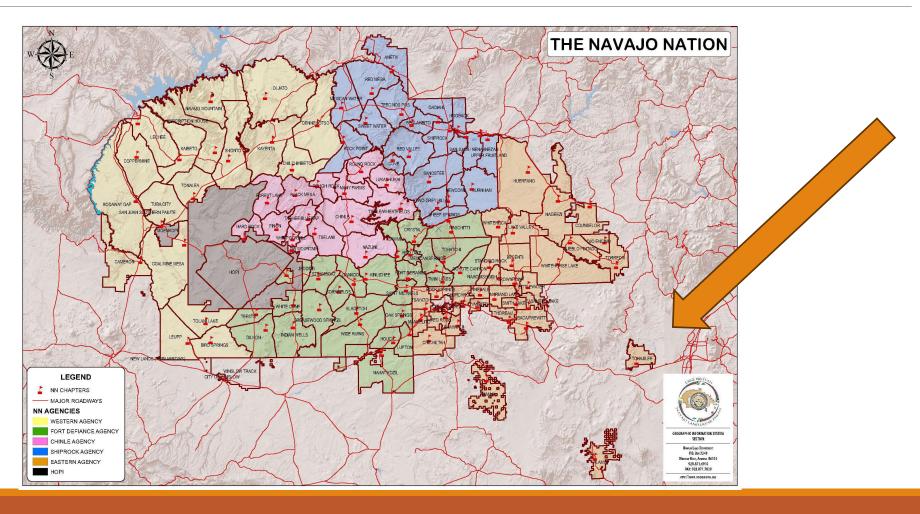

Current Community Health Disparities

- Water disparity in Tohajiilee Community We have issues with people lacking access to clean water close to home because of the high rate of sulfur in the water system. The clinic engages in providing free and providing clean drinking water to many community members. Water scarcity threatens the health and development of communities.
- ■Water deprivations can spur the transmission of diseases such as cholera, typhoid, polio, hepatitis A, and diarrhea.
- □ Food Disparity in the community is threaten by water scarcity making agriculture much more difficult, it threatens a community's access to food.
- □ Food-insecure communities can face both acute and chronic hunger, increasing at risk conditions stemming from malnutrition, such as stunting and wasting, and chronic illnesses due to poor diet, such as diabetes.
