



Diné College (DC) was established in 1968 as the first tribal college in the United States. It is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (hlcommission.org), a regional accreditation agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education, and serves students primarily in Arizona and New Mexico within the Navajo Nation. With a student body that is 92% Navajo, DC is a four-year institution offering associate, bachelor's, master's, and certificate programs. The main campus, located in Tsaile, features student dormitories and a cafeteria. Additionally, the college participates in various athletic competitions, including rodeo, archery, and cross-country. Governance of the college is managed by an eight-member board of regents.


