RELATING TO REDISTRICTING; CREATING THE COUNTY AND MUNICIPALITY REDISTRICTING TASK FORCE; REQUIRING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO CONVENE THE COUNTY AND MUNICIPALITY REDISTRICTING TASK FORCE TO RECOMMEND REDISTRICTING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR NEW MEXICO COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES FOLLOWING THE 2030 FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. TEMPORARY PROVISION--COUNTY AND MUNICIPALITY
REDISTRICTING TASK FORCE--CREATED--FINDINGS--REPORT.--

A. The "county and municipality redistricting task force" is created and shall function from the date of its appointment until December 1, 2024. The local government division of the department of finance and administration shall .223448.3

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be the fiscal agent for the task force and shall contract with the New Mexico association of counties and the New Mexico municipal league to convene the task force.

- The task force shall study the redistricting plans of each county and municipality and develop recommendations to standardize the policies and procedures for redistricting across all counties and municipalities following the 2030 federal decennial census. The task force shall hold public meetings, hear testimony and receive public comment.
- The task force shall hire or contract with a consultant or expert to provide the task force with information to assist in developing its recommendations.
- Task force members shall be appointed by the New Mexico association of counties and the New Mexico municipal league and shall include local elected officials, community leaders of different populations within the counties and municipalities, a representative of the New Mexico association of counties and a representative of the New Mexico municipal league.
- Public members of the task force may receive per diem and mileage as provided for nonsalaried public officers in the Per Diem and Mileage Act and shall receive no other compensation, perquisite or allowance.
- The task force shall report and present its findings and recommendations to the appropriate interim .223448.3

legislative committee before December 1, 2024.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal years 2024 and 2025 to convene the county and municipality redistricting task force to study and develop recommended redistricting procedures for New Mexico counties and municipalities and to pay the expenses incurred by the task force. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2025 shall revert to the general fund.

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
