

Santa Fe Indian School Entrance Project

Project Description

Santa Fe Indian School (SFIS) has committed to establish a new main entry for the campus. The school is located in Santa Fe, New Mexico and was originally established in 1890 to educate Native American children from the tribes throughout the southwest. Today, SFIS is managed by the 19 Pueblos and educates over 700 students yearly in grades 7 - 12 from New Mexico. This student population also includes students from the Jicarilla and Mescalero Apache Nations and students from the Navajo Nation. Demographically, our students reside in over 15 New Mexico Counties.

The Overall Conceptual Entryway Plan consists of the addition of a new main entry including drive, deceleration lane, security guard shelter and landscaping to enhance the public face of the school, improve way-finding, while reducing the safety concerns currently arising at a shared entrance located at the 2nd street & Cerrillos intersection.

Campus Safety and Security, is a primary concern for the SFIS, especially since the SFIS boards over 500 students from the ages 12 - 18. A deceleration lane at project intersecting Cerrillos is planned to improve vehicular safety for those entering and leaving our campus. The revitalized entrance will alleviate primary use of the 2nd street & Cerrillos road intersection, which has a high a volume of vehicle accidents due to lack of turning lanes and lack of proper directional lighting.

Project Construction Budget

Total Construction Costs Phase One & Two \$2,955,854.82

Phase I Construction Costs

a) \$900,000.00 GO Bond Will allow for the roadway work to begin, which will include construction management, demolition, excavation.

Balance to complete project \$2,055,854.82, after GO Bond Funding of \$900,000.00

b) Previously delayed phase I funding \$1,027,927.00 (FY2020-2024) requested through SFIS ICIP submitted will complete, grading, curb and gutter and fencing to be constructed.

Phase II Construction Costs \$1,027,927.00 (FY2021-2025)

Will allow for the completion of the roadway surfacing, guardhouse construction, site lighting and full landscape to be implemented.
