




Rural Hospital Updates


- Limited behavioral health resources and bed availability in the State.
- ❖ Increasing ER volumes, from an average daily census of 44 in 2022, to 55 in 2024 likely related to lack of primary care resources.
- Limited ground transportation availability for patients needing tertiary care facilities. Most patients are transported via fixed wing or rotor.
- Limited bed availability for high-level care in the State; Heart Attack, Stroke, Multi-trauma patients are getting harder and harder to place.




The demand for registered nurses is expected to rise 40 percent by 2020, compared with a rise of only 6 percent in the supply. By 2020, the nation will have a shortage of more than 808,000 RNs, according to Department of Health and Human Services projections.
