
Who We Are

 - **5% Other**




Patients Served

Patient Mix Income/Poverty Level




■ < 100% ■ 101%-150% ■ 151%-200% ■ > 200% ■







Substance Use







Behavioral Health Challenges

- **Demand for Opioid Replacement Therapy Exceeds Supply. Wait Times Average 4-6 months**
- **Timely Access to Specialized Services**
 - Substance Use Residential Treatment
 - Intensive Out Patient Treatment
 - Psychiatric Services
- **Socioeconomic Factors Affecting Patient Care**
- **Recruitment and Retention of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Counselors**
- **No Public Transportation**
