Allied Health Certificate Programs

- Allied Health Certificate
 - 30 credit hour (2-semesters) program
 - facilitate admission into a Nursing program or employment in healthcare
- Dental Assistant Certificate
 - 36 credit hour (1-year) program
 - Commission on Dental Accreditation
- Emergency Medical Technician-Basic
 - 11 credit hour program
 - prepares individuals to sit for National Registry EMT certification exam

Continuing Education Programs

- Certified Nurses Assistant (CNA)
 - One week of theory class (8am-5pm)
 - One week of clinicals (8am-5pm)
 - Course provides basic knowledge and skills necessary by nursing assistants to deliver safe and effective care
- CPR
 - 1 credit hour course (about 40+ contact hours)
 - Offered in varying schedule formats
 - Required course for other allied health programs as well as a continuing education course for health care professionals in the field

Allied Health AAS Programs

- Allied Health
 - 60 credit hours (2-year) program
 - purpose is to prepare students to either transfer into an allied health career program or to a pre-professional program at a four year college
- Nursing (Registered Nurse)
 - 68 credit hours
 - Prepares students for board licensure
